I made contact with the owner a Barry Manthe. I informed him that his vehicle had been found and that the keys were still in it, and that it was in Glenwood, Iowa. I then gave him the phone number 712-527-5498, which is the phone number for the towing company.

Supplement report is being done and added to the original case number, and a MULES/NCIC clearance form was given to Joint Communications by this officer. The vehicle will be taken out of the CAPS computer system by Sgt. Drew Wheeler. Contact will be made with the Iowa State Highway Patrol to release the vehicle to its owner.
