On 02-20-97 at approximately 1755 HRS, I was dispatched to 802 Business Loop 70 East reference a missing vehicle.

Upon arrival at that location, I made contact with the complainant and owner of the missing vehicle, BARRY MANTHE. Mr. Manthe advised that

approximately twenty minutes prior to my arrival his vehicle had been stolen from in front of the business. He stated that the vehicle was parked at the business of Clover located at 802 Business Loop 70 East.

He advised that the vehicle was parked facing west on North Boulevard which is on the south side of the business. Mr. Manthe stated that he parked the vehicle and went in the store and was inside for approximately ten minutes. He stated that when he came out the vehicle was gone. Mr. Manthe stated that the keys were still in the vehicle and it was not locked.

Mr. Manthe advised that the vehicle was a 1985 Plymouth Voyager bearing Wisconsin plates. He stated that there was only one plate on the back and none on the front. He reported that there was no tab on the rear license plate as someone had taken it. Mr. Manthe stated that the vehicle was silver in color with maroon interior and had wood panelling on the sides. He stated that on one side of the vehicle (which side is unknown) part of the panelling was missing.

Mr. Manthe stated that he did not know the odometer reading and would not take a guess on how many miles were on the vehicle. He stated that there was approximately one-third of a tank of gas left in the vehicle.

Mr. Manthe stated that he had dropped off an employee at the muffler place at Rangeline and Business Loop, and then proceeded to Clover's. He stated that he left his residence at approximately 1700 HRS to 1715 HRS.

I spoke with several employees inside the business who stated that they did not see anyone take the vehicle. I was advised that he was actually in the store approximately thirty minutes, rather than ten minutes.

I then escorted Mr. Manthe to his residence where he obtained the VIN number from records. A check through the Department of Revenue's MULES/NCIC system indicated that the license plate on the vehicle should be PWZ-586 through the state of Wisconsin.

I checked the tow file at the Columbia Police Department and it did not appear as though the vehicle had been towed. Mr. Manthe stated that he does not owe any money on it and does not owe anyone any money. He stated that he did not have any idea who would have taken the vehicle.

I then responded to the Columbia Police Department to complete the appropriate paperwork to enter the vehicle into MULES as stolen. I was then advised by CSA Beth Carlson that she had received a call from Crime Blockers who stated that this vehicle had been seen approximately one hour ago parked down the street from 1203 Jefferson, which is where Mr. Manthe lives. Carlson advised that she received this call at approximately 7:30 PM.

I then responded and made contact with Mr. Manthe and spoke with him about this issue. Mr. Manthe was adamant about the fact that he did not know who had his vehicle.

An entry was made into MULES and a BOLO for a Stop & Hold on this vehicle was entered with Joint Communications. At this time, there is nothing further.
