Over the course of the last week, I have been receiving information that there is a crack house at 1003 Jefferson. I was given the name of Celeste Jost and Clayton Sharpe as being the people who live there. It is my understanding that Jost was arrested for a Parole Violation and is no longer living at the address. According to the individuals that I have been speaking with, Clayton Sharpe is still staying there. They said that when people come to the residence, Sharpe then leaves the residence and goes to an address at 1007 Wilkes and a couple of addresses on Leeway in Columbia and obtains the crack-cocaine. He then returns to 1003 Jefferson and delivers the cocaine. There are numerous individuals in and out of 1003 Jefferson, buying and smoking crack-cocaine. It

is my understanding that Jost was the one renting this residence, therefore it is unknown how long Sharpe will continue to live at this address.

On 04/26/98 and the early morning of 04/27/98, I watched some traffic in and out of 1003 Jefferson. There were several vehicle driving in the area and people going in and out of the residence. I observed Bernard King, in his Ford Explorer, to drive past the residence. King observed my patrol vehicle on Jefferson, therefore he did not stop at the residence. I observed Wayne Logwood's vehicle to be parked in front of the residence for several hours. I also observed a '91 Ford escort to be sitting in the driveway at 1003 Jefferson. I later observed this vehicle at 1207 Rangeline. This residence is associated with Barry Manthe. I then later observed this vehicle to be back in the driveway at 1003 Jefferson.

The vehicle 835DTY, is a '91 Ford 2-door, checking to a Jackie O. Herndon, of 703 S. 13th St. in St. Joseph. I ran Jackie Herndon through the Department of Revenue computer and obtained further information on her. All this information was added to our computer at the Columbia Police Department.

Based on the subjects that I saw in the area, and the amount of traffic that was around 1003 Jefferson, it is believed that the information that I received was good information. On 04/27/98 and in the early morning hours of 04/28/98, I again noticed a lot of vehicular traffic in the 1000 block of Jefferson. Bernard Kings Explorer was parked out front of the residence for a while. I also observed a vehicle which I did not recognize to be sitting in the driveway and was later observed parked on the street in front of the residence. The vehicle had Missouri plates 316-AHP which checked to Annette McPherson, on a green 1993 Chevy. I also had a call at this address. For further information on the call, see case #98-005271.

While inside the residence, I observed a broken glass crack pipe and several burnt pieces of wire laying in almost every room in the residence. There were also several knives laying around. Sharpe was intoxicated and seemed to be extremely nervous during my visit. A copy of this report will be forwarded to the Narcotics Unit for their information and actions.
