On 05/10/98 I responded to CPD to make contact with Cynthia Pemberton reference being assaulted. She said at approximately 9:30 p.m. she went to the KP on Rangeline to buy cigarettes. While there she started talking with a friend named Damion. She said she didn't know his last name.

While at KP, she said her ex-boyfriend, Christopher Haynes, drove up. Pemberton said that Haynes and Damion got into it over her and that Haynes is very jealous. She said she left and walked back to her residence at 1207 Rangeline and Haynes followed her. Once at the residence he began demanding money. When she said no, he began striking her in the head. She said he struck her four times in the back of the head and neck "very hard" knocking her to the ground. She said she blacked out for several seconds. When she got away from him, she went out the back door and hid from him.

Pemberton then came to the police station to file a report. While at the police department she was seen by Boone Hospital paramedics. At that time, she refused medical treatment.

Pemberton said that a Barry Manthe witnessed the assault. I spoke to Manthe who said he saw Hanes hit Pemberton in the head at least two times. I asked him why he was assaulting her and he said she refused to give Haynes money. He refused to say anything else about the incident.

Pemberton said that she is afraid of Haynes and believes that he will kill her. She said they have never lived together and don't have any children in common. She also indicated that this is not the first time he has beat her. The last incident occurred three weeks ago when he beat her and put her in the hospital. She didn't file charges.

At this time I have issued a stop and hold for Haynes for third degree assault. I have also filed a warrant for his arrest.
