On 07-11-98, I was continuing an ongoing investigation. As a result of the investigation, I purchased a twenty (\$20.00) dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine from Kimberly M. Long and Gregory B. Johnston.

On 07-11-98, at approximately 1954 hours, I contacted Kimberly M. Long and a white female known only as "Cindy" at Kneaded Relief, 1207 Rangeline. Upon arriving at the location, I was met at the door by Barry P. Manthe, the manager of Kneaded Relief. The name Kneaded Relief is prominently displayed on the front door of the building. I entered the building and began speaking with Long and "Cindy". I asked both if either one knew where I could locate some "rock," meaning "crack" cocaine. Both women indicated that if I could wait or come back in a short time, that they could accommodate me with the "crack" cocaine. I indicated to both women that I would return in approximately ten (10) minutes. I then left the building.

At approximately 2013 hours, I returned to the building at 1207 Rangeline, and again made contact with Long and "Cindy." Long then took over the business of conducting the transaction. Long indicated that the subject who was to retrieve the "crack" cocaine had not retrieved enough, and they would have to go retrieve more. Long indicated that I could give her the money to go and retrieve the "crack" cocaine, or I could follow her and the other person, later identified as Gregory B. Johnston, half of the way to the "crack" cocaine. I accepted the latter, and Long indicated that she would wait with me at the halfway point.

At approximately 2024, I left the building, following a brown, four door Oldsmobile station wagon, bearing Missouri registration 359-AAY. Driving the station wagon was Johnston, and Long was a passenger in the front seat. At approximately 2027 hours, Johnston pulled into the parking lot of the gas station, and Long stepped from the vehicle. Long indicated that I would have to give her ten (\$10.00) dollars, so that Johnston could then take the money and obtain "crack" cocaine. I then handed Long one (1) ten (\$10.00) dollar bill. Long then handed the money to Johnston. Johnston then left the parking lot, traveling across Paris Road, onto Hinkson. Long went into the gas station, and came out a short time later. Long then got into my vehicle with me, and we waited at the gas station for Johnston to return.

At approximately 2041 hours, Johnston returned to the gas station, and parked the station wagon next to my vehicle. Long then indicated that I should give her the other ten (\$10.00) dollars needed for the "twenty rock." I handed her the money, and she stepped from my vehicle and stepped to the window and handed the money to Johnston. Long then reached into the station wagon. Long then turned around and leaned in the passenger window of my vehicle. Long handed me a white crumbly chunk, purported to be "crack" cocaine. I then thanked Long and Johnston and left the gas station at approximately 2042 hours.

Following the transaction, I then met with Detective Himmel, of the Columbia Police Department, who had monitored and surveilled me during this transaction. I recovered from Detective Himmel one (1) cassette tape. Prior to the transaction, I concealed a recording device on myself. The conversation with Long, Johnston, "Cindy" and Manthe is contained on a microcassette tape, dated 07-11-98.

I also performed a field test on the "crack" cocaine with a positive result. The "crack" cocaine and the two (2) cassette tapes were placed into evidence at the Columbia Police Department. The "crack" cocaine will be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol Lab for analysis.

Kimberly M. Long was identified with the use of a photograph in the Columbia Police Department mug shot system. Long was wearing a pink dress during this transaction. Gregory B. Johnston was identified with the use of a photograph in the Columbia Police Department mug shot system. Johnston was wearing blue jeans and a multi-colored shirt during the transaction. "Cindy" is believed to be Cynthia Marie Pemberton, date of birth 01-25-58, social security number 498-66-6772. During my contact with Pemberton, she indicated that she is the current girlfriend of Christopher K. "Creole" Haynes. According to information located at the Columbia Police Department, Pemberton is listed as Haynes current girlfriend, and Pemberton matches the physical description of "Cindy." Barry P. Manthe was identified with the use of a photograph in the Columbia Police Department mug shot system.
