On 07-17-98, I was continuing an ongoing investigation. As a result of the investigation, I purchased a one hundred (\$100.00) dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine from Kimberly M. Long, Gregory B. Johnston, and an unknown black male.

On 07-17-98, at approximately 2057 hours, I contacted Barry P. Manthe at the back door of "Kneaded Relief," located at 1207 Rangeline. I asked Manthe if he knew where I could locate "K," also known as Kimberly M. Long? Manthe turned and called to Long. Upon contacting Long, I asked her if she knew where I could locate a "hundred rock," meaning a one hundred (\$100.00)

dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine? Long indicated that she did know where to locate the "crack" cocaine, and that I should wait for just a moment. After a brief moment, Gregory B. Johnston appeared in the back door of the business. Johnston then asked if we could go in my car, and I told him that we could.

At approximately 2155 hours, Long, Johnston and I left "Kneaded Relief," and Johnston indicated that I should take him across the street to the Super 7 Motel. I pulled into the parking lot at the motel, Johnston got out of the car and moved out of my sight. After a short time, he came back to the car and directed me to leave the parking lot. Johnston then gave me directions to Wilkes Boulevard. Johnston also indicated that I would need to give him the money before we got to the residence. At approximately 2111 hours, I pulled onto the 700 block of Wilkes Boulevard and handed Johnston one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of Columbia Police Department money. Johnston then got out of the car and walked to a residence on the North side of Wilkes Boulevard. At approximately 2115 hours, Johnston got back into my vehicle, and directed me to drive back to 1207 Rangeline, that the person was not there. As we started pulling away from the curb, I observed a red Pontiac Grand Prix pulling into a driveway on Wilkes Boulevard, near the location Johnston had been. Johnston then said that "she" was there now, and to go on to the house on Rangeline. Johnston said that if "Mary" was out, then he could get more money, and he could obtain a larger quantity of "crack" cocaine, and he would only have to make one trip. I drove back to 1207 Rangeline, and Johnston went into the residence for a short time.

When Johnston came back out of the residence, he directed me back to the 700 block of Wilkes Boulevard. As we were coming up to the residence Johnston had previously indicated, he said that I needed to let someone into the car. I asked him who, and he pointed to a black male wearing North Carolina shorts and no shirt. As I slowed down as instructed, Johnston opened the right back door of my vehicle. The unknown black male would not get into the vehicle. Johnston then instructed me to pull over to the curb and park. Johnston then got out of the car. At approximately 2123 hours, Johnston got back into my car, and indicated that I should return to 1207 Rangeline so that he could cut the "crack" cocaine. Johnston also indicated that someone had cheated him out of some money. Johnston said that "Steve" supposedly gave him thirty (\$30.00) dollars, and that I had supposedly given him one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Johnston said that when he got inside to get the "crack" cocaine, he only one hundred eight (\$100.00) dollars. I informed Johnston that I had given him three (3) twenty (\$20.00) dollar bills and four (4) ten (\$10.00) dollar bills. Johnston agreed that I had given him the correct amount of money and calmed down.

Upon our arrival at 1207 Rangeline, Long, Johnston and I went into the residence. Johnston and Long went into a back bedroom to "cut up" the "crack"

cocaine. Inside the residence, I observed two white males, one known as Barry P. Manthe and the second known only as "Steve." I also observed a white female that I did not recognize. Long called me into the southeast bedroom, and handed me a large piece of white crumbly substance. I then left the residence.

I returned to the Columbia Police Department where I field tested the white crumbly substance. The field test was positive for the presence of cocaine. I then placed the "crack" cocaine into evidence, along with a microcassette tape containing the conversation between Long, Johnston and myself. The "crack" cocaine will be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol Crime Lab for analysis.

During this transaction, Long was wearing black spandex, knee length, pants, and a gray tank top. Johnston was wearing blue jeans and a white T-shirt.
