On 07-24-98, I was continuing an ongoing investigation. As a result of the investigation, I purchased a one hundred (\$100.00) dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine from Kimberly M. Long, Gregory B. Johnston, and Raymond L. Martin.

On 07-24-98, at approximately 0100 hours, I contacted Johnston at the front door of Kneaded Relief, located at 1207 Rangeline. I asked Johnston if he could get me a "hundred," meaning a one hundred (\$100.00) dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine. Johnston said that he could, and invited me inside the business. I went inside and observed Barry P. Manthe, the manager of Kneaded Relief, two unknown white females, and two unknown black males. I followed Johnston into the southeast bedroom and observed Kimberly M. Long, seated on the bed. I waited for Johnston to make a some telephone calls, and then Johnston began speaking with an unknown individual.

While Johnston was on the telephone, another male walked into the business and began speaking with Manthe. The unknown male was asking for "Sandy," and asked if she was with a client. Johnston then instructed Long to go see about the client. Long went into the main room of the business, and Johnston got off the telephone. Johnston then told me that he was ready to go, and we went outside of the business. Johnston, Long and I then left and drove to the corner of Orr and Walnut Streets. At approximately 0113 hours, Johnston told me to give him the money, and wait in the car, that he needed to find someone at the "Club." I counted out one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and handed the money to Johnston. Johnston was gone for a few minutes, and then he returned. Johnston then told me to drive by the "Club," which turned out to be Lou's Palace, on Walnut Street. I drove by Lou's Palace slowly, as Johnston indicated, and he did not observe the person he was looking for. After a few moments of driving around, Johnston said that he needed to use a telephone. I then handed Johnston my departmental issued cellular telephone, and he called the number 821-4151, which I obtained after the transaction from the memory of the telephone.

Johnston spoke with an unknown person for a brief moment and then hung up. Johnston then said that he would be meeting the person in the alley behind the Ramada Inn hotel, located at 1111 East Broadway. Johnston then left the car and returned shortly to hand me a white crumbly chunk, at approximately 0128 hours. Johnston then told me to go into the parking lot of the Ramada Inn and pick up the person he had just spoken to. I drove to the parking lot, and Johnston pointed to a black male, wearing a yellow ball cap, blue shorts, and a plaid shirt. The black male got into my vehicle, and I was instructed in driving until eventually dropping the black male off at the corner of Fifth and Park streets. During this time, Johnston called the black male "Vance." When I was able to see the black male's face, during a stop at a convenience store, I recognized the black male as the same person that I had seen from another

transaction; refer to case number 98-009265. I recognized the black male as Raymond L. Martin, whom I had recognized from a photograph at the Columbia Police Department.

After leaving Martin, I then drove Johnston and Long back to Kneaded Relief and parted company with them. I then drove back to the Columbia Police Department, where I field tested the white crumbly chunk, which tested positive for the presence of cocaine. I then placed the "crack" cocaine into evidence, along with a microcassette tape, containing the conversation surrounding the transaction. The "crack" cocaine will be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol Crime Lab for analysis.

During the transaction, Long was wearing purple pants and a long tan colored shirt. Johnston was wearing black shorts and a green shirt.
