INCIDENT NARRATIVE

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NARRATIVE

At approximately 11:44 PM on 07/31/98, while on routine patrol in the area of Business Loop 70 and Rangeline, I made contact with two individuals in reference to a verbal disturbance behind the residence at 1207 Rangeline Rd., South. During the course of my contact with those individuals, I identified both subjects as Traci Sapp and Jeffery Mosley. I also made contact with a white male inside the residence, later identified as Barry Manthe. For further information pertaining to the disturbance and its outcome, refer to case number 98010073.

While speaking with Manthe about the disturbance, Manthe related that Mosley had been involved in a leaving the scene accident earlier in the evening. Manthe stated that Mosley's vehicle, a red Chevy Nova, was parked on the south side of his residence and that Mosley had come into his residence approximately 30 minutes prior to my contact with him, stating he had been involved in an accident. Manthe stated that Mosley told him that he had struck a building on Gordon St. and that the police were looking for him. Manthe also related that Mosley had told him that he wanted to hide out in the residence until "the coast was clear."

At that time, I contact Officer Tim Timmerman. Officer Timmerman had been investigating the leaving the scene accident which had occurred on Gordon St. I advised him that I had Mosley in my company, as well as his possible suspect vehicle. Officer Timmerman then advised that his suspect vehicle was, in fact, a red Chevrolet Nova. He also stated that he believed a white male had been driving that vehicle.

I then examined the vehicle located on the south side of the building of 1207 Rangeline. That vehicle was a 1987 red, 4-door Chevy Nova. The vehicle was bearing Missouri license 092HMG. The vehicle had minor front end damage on the bumper and left front quarter panel. The vehicle was also missing its rear window, and had a small dent on the left side rear passenger door. The damage on the front bumper consisted of several scratch marks and what appeared to be a white and brown color. The passenger side front turn signal underneath the bumper was damaged, as well as the left front corner of the bumper and material near it. I relayed the information of the damage to Officer Timmerman. He stated that that damage coincided with the damage which he believed to have occurred during the leaving the scene accident on Gordon. Officer Timmerman then advised that he would respond to my location and make contact with Mosley.

Mosley had been uncooperative during my investigation of this disturbance. During that investigation, Mosley was handcuffed for his safety as well as the safety of officers on the scene. Mosley was extremely verbally belligerent and  
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physically uncooperative at several times during my contact with him. During one point in the discussion which I had with Mosley over the disturbance, he admitted that he had drank seven beers during the evening. Mosley also stated that the vehicle on the south side of the building was his, and that no one else had been driving it. Mosley would not indicate to me whether or not he had driven the vehicle on 07/31/98, or why he had been at 1207 Rangeline. Mosley denied any knowledge of an accident when I contacted him.

Officer Timmerman arrived on the scene at approximately 12:30 AM on 08/01/98. Officer Timmerman then spoke with Mosley and obtained a limited confession in reference to the accident. For further information pertaining to Officer Timmerman's incident, refer to his report under the same case number.

At the request of Officer Timmerman, I took photographs of the damage to the vehicle, and of the vehicle. The vehicle was left at the scene after photographs had been taken. The keys to the vehicle were turned over to Mosley's mother, who had arrived on the scene in reference to the original disturbance.

As stated earlier, for any further information pertaining to the disturbance, refer to case number 98010073. For any further information pertaining to this incident, refer to Officer Timmerman's report.
