At approximately 11:44 p.m. on 07-31-98 while on routine patrol in a marked patrol vehicle in the area of Business Loop 70 and Rangeline I observed a white female and a white male in what appeared to be a verbal argument behind the residence at 1207 S. Rangeline Road.

I approached those subjects in the driveway and exited my patrol vehicle. I

separated both individuals who were by that time involved in a heated verbal argument. As I was exiting my patrol vehicle I observed the white male, later identified as Jeffery P. Mosley, strike the top of a blue abandoned vehicle in the rear of the residence with his open fist. I immediately summoned back up and escorted Mosley to the side of the building. Mosley was extremely verbally uncooperative and continually acted as if he was going to leave without speaking to me. Due to the unknown circumstances surrounding the disturbance and Mosley's behavior I placed handcuffs on his wrists for my safety as well as his until back up could arrive.

After separating both individuals I identified the female as Traci Sapp. I questioned Sapp independently of Mosley. Sapp indicated that she and Mosley had been in a verbal argument because he had found her out with someone else during the evening. She stated that she and Mosley had been living together at his parents' residence on E. Karen Avenue and that they had went their separate ways this evening. Sapp indicated that she believed their relationship was "on the rocks" and was soon to end. Sapp stated that Mosley had not struck her nor had she struck him at any point during the disturbance and that they had merely been arguing when I approached them.

I then recontacted Mosley. Mosley was extremely uncooperative and did not want to relate the events of the disturbance to me. By this time Officer Dan Beckman had arrived to assist. Officer Beckman and I spoke with Mosley at length. Mosley continually cussed at us and called us "assholes". He stated that he hated the Columbia Police Department and that we were not there to do anything for him. Mosley did state that he had consumed approximately seven beers earlier in the evening. Mosley also indicated that he was a frequent user of cocaine, although he stated he had not used any cocaine in the last three days.

After speaking with Mosley for an extended period of time he did relate that he had caught Sapp with another man and was upset about that. Mosley stated that no physical disturbance had occurred and he was willing to go back to his parents' residence. I recontacted Sapp. She stated that she had a friend who could pick her up and that she would stay separated from Mosley for at least the next day and a half. Sapp made a telephone call at the residence at 1207 Rangeline and had a friend pick her up.

At that time I made contact with a white male at 1207 Rangeline Road. That individual was later identified as Barry Manthe. Manthe stated he was the resident and proprietor of Kneaded Relief at 1207 Rangeline. He stated that he wanted Mosley given a trespass warning for the property. Manthe also related that Mosley had told him he had been involved in a leaving the scene accident. Mosley was eventually arrested by Officer Tim Timmerman for charges related to the leaving the scene accident. No charges were filed in reference to this disturbance.

Both subjects were provided with Missouri Adult Abuse cards. Sapp stated that she would feel comfortable with her friend for the evening. Mosley again was uncooperative and would not respond when asked if any further disturbances would occur.

Upon my return to the police department I placed a 12 hour rule between Sapp and Mosley through Joint Communications. I also issued Mosley a trespass warning for 1207 Rangeline at the request of Manthe.
