On 08-12-98, I was continuing an ongoing narcotics investigation, when I purchased a twenty (\$20.00) dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine from Cynthia M. Pemberton.

On 08-12-98, at approximately 1826 hours, I arrived at Kneaded Relief, located at 1207 Rangeline, and made contact with Cynthia M. Pemberton. Pemberton asked what I needed, and I indicated that I needed a "twenty rock," meaning a twenty (\$20.00) dollar "rock" of "crack" cocaine. Pemberton indicated that she knew where to get the "crack" cocaine, that we would only need to go down the street. Pemberton and I then left Kneaded Relief and traveled to 910 Eighth Street. A white four door, Nissan vehicle was in the driveway, bearing Missouri registration 996-HMG. Pemberton indicated that she needed the money before going into the residence. At approximately 1831 hours, I handed twenty (\$20.00) dollars, and she then went into the apartment on the right, on the north side of the residence, when facing south. Pemberton went inside the residence and spoke with an unknown black male. After approximately two (2) minutes, Pemberton returned from within the residence. Pemberton and I then returned to Kneaded Relief.

Upon our arrival at Kneaded Relief, Pemberton asked me to come inside the business with her because she was there alone. Pemberton asked that I come inside and smoke the "crack" cocaine with her. To protect the integrity and confidentiality, I indicated to Pemberton, who was still in possession of the "crack" cocaine, that I would prefer her just take a piece of the "crack" cocaine. Pemberton broke a piece of the "crack" cocaine off, and then handed me the remainder, at approximately 1835 hours. Pemberton then got out of my vehicle, thus completing the transaction.

During my contact with Pemberton, I indicated that I was interested in making extra money. Pemberton told me that I could make good money working at Kneaded Relief. Pemberton informed me that I could make one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per "client," and that "Barry," meaning Barry P. Manthe,

only got twenty (\$20.00) dollars per "client." Pemberton also informed me that to make this money, all I needed was to have plenty of condoms.

I then took the white crumbly chunk to the Columbia Police Department, where I performed a field test, and received a positive field test on the "crack" cocaine. The cocaine was placed into evidence and will be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol crime lab for analysis. I also taped the conversation between Pemberton and myself. The microcassette tape was also placed into evidence at the Columbia Police Department.

During the transaction, Pemberton was wearing a plaid shirt and brown boxer shorts.
