On 09-15-98, I was continuing an ongoing undercover investigation. As a result of the investigation, I purchased thirty dollars (\$30.00) worth of "crack" cocaine from Dorothy T. Kee, also known as "Twyla" and "Essence."

On 09-15-98, I was at Kneaded Relief, located at 1207 Rangeline, Columbia, Missouri, speaking with Barry P. Manthe, when I observed Dorothy T. Kee in the business. At approximately 1859 hours, after speaking with Manthe, I made contact with Kee in the Southwest bedroom of the business. I asked Kee if she had a "twenty," meaning a twenty dollar (\$20.00) piece of "crack" cocaine. Kee informed me that she had some crumbs that she would sell me for thirty dollars (\$30.00). At approximately 1802 hours, Kee and I were interrupted by other business. At approximately 1805 hours, Kee and I were able to return to the same bedroom, and complete the business of the sale of "crack" cocaine. I handed Kee thirty dollars (\$30.00) of Columbia Police Department money. Kee then wrapped the small white crumbly crumbs into plastic and handed the "crack" cocaine to me. After brief conversation with Manthe and Kee, I left the business, thus completing the transaction with Kee.

I then returned to the Columbia Police Department, and field tested the white crumbly chunks, which resulted in a positive test for the presence of cocaine. I then placed the "crack" cocaine into evidence at the Columbia Police Department. The "crack" cocaine will be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol Laboratory for analysis. I also placed into evidence a micro-cassette tape containing the conversation between myself and Kee. This tape is a copy of the original, which was placed into evidence under another Columbia Police Department case number 98-012381.

During the transaction, Kee was wearing blue jean short cutoffs and a black tank top.

This transaction took place at 1207 Rangeline, Columbia, Missouri, which is within 2000 feet of Eugene Field Elementary School, which meets the requirements of 195.214.
