INCIDENT NARRATIVE

ON 4/24/14, RC AND BM, REPORTED BEING ROBBED AT GUNPOINT  
BY TWO BLACK MALES IN THE 1100 BLOCK OF VANDIVER DRIVE  
ON 04/17/14 AT APPROXIMATELY 0130 HOURS.

On 4/24/2014, at approximately 1141 hours, I responded to the Columbia Police Department Lobby located at 600 East Walnut Street, in reference to Ronald Clark wanting to a report a robbery.

Clark said he was robbed at gunpoint on 4/17/2014, at approximately 0130 hours at his residence located at 1125 Vandiver Drive. He said his roommate, Barry Manthe, was also a victim of the robbery.

Clark said that at approximately 0130 hours, on 4/17/2014, he was taking his trash out to the back dumpster at his house. He said he left the front door to the house unlocked and walked back in the house to grab more trash. He said he walked in his bedroom and turned around. He told me there were two black males with guns pointed at him. He said these black males both told him to "give me your money." He said he had \$50.00 in cash in his pants pocket that he was wearing. He said he got the \$50.00 out of his pocket and gave it them. He said both males questioned him weather or not that was all the money he had. He said he told them that was all he had. He said the subjects began striking him on the top of the head and face, four to eight times, with the butt of their guns.

He described the first suspect as a black male approximately 5 foot 10, approximately 200 pounds, in his late twenties or early thirties. He said the subject did not have any facial hair and had short black hair. He said he was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and some type of pants. He said he did not observe any visible tattoos or distinguishable marks on the subject.

He described the second suspect as a black male approximately 5 foot 8, approximately 160 pounds, that was in his upper thirties or lower forties. He said this suspect had grey short hair. He said this suspect was wearing a grey sweatshirt and pants. He said this suspect did not have any facial hair and was lighter complected than the first suspect. He said the suspect was also wearing an unknown colored baseball cap.

Clark told me could positively identify both suspects if he were to see them again. He said both suspects had black "automatic type" handguns that they were both carrying in their right hands.

Clark said that after both suspects struck him with their guns, they walked him back to the back room where Manthe was sleeping. He said when the suspects did this he thought the suspects would have had to have prior knowledge of the residence as they knew where the back room was.

Clark said once they got in the back room where Manthe was sleeping the suspects woke Manthe up. Clark said they told Manthe to give them his money. Clark said Manthe removed approximately \$700.00 from a wallet that was in a drawer next to his bed. Clark said Manthe gave the suspects the money. Clark said the suspects then stole Manthe's phone, which was next to his bed.

Clark reported the suspects then struck Manthe several times in the head with the butt of their hand guns. Clark said they pushed him down face first on the bed where he laid for several minutes. He said the suspects then left. He said he laid on the bed for a few minutes until he did not hear the suspects moving around his house. He said he then got up and locked the front door to the house.

Clark said he did not call the police because the suspects had threatened if he reported it, they would come back. Clark said that on 4/23/2014, he still had injuries from being struck with the hand guns so he took himself to the Boone Hospital Emergency Room and saw Doctor Thomas Coyle (449-4900). Clark said that he was told he had a fractured face.

Clark provided a telephone number for Manthe. I called Manthe. Manthe reported that on 4/17/2014, in the early morning hours he was the victim of an armed robbery. Manthe said he was in the back room sleeping when he was awoken by two black males with guns. He said he did not get a look at one of the suspects, but the other suspect was a black male, approximately fifty years old and approximately 150 pounds. He said he could not provide an approximate height for the suspect because he was not "good at that." He said the suspect had white whiskers and could possibly be Clifford Lake. He said Clifford Lake had dealt heroine to some females that were at the house approximately one year prior to report date. He said that he did not know what Clifford Lake looked like because he did not physically see him when he was dealing heroin, but just thought that it could be him because he had knowledge of their residence and he had been at their house in the past.

Manthe reported that he could probably identify the suspect if he were to see him again.

Manthe said the suspects also stole his phone that was sitting next to the bed. Manthe reported the phone was a black straight talk flip phone. He could not provide a serial number for it and valued it at approximately \$50.00. He said that the phone number had been 5733562454.

Manthe said both suspects struck him with the butt of their guns. He said he got struck approximately two times in the head and this caused him to bleed. Manthe said that after the suspects did this, they left the residence.

He said that Clark and he did not call the police as the suspects threatened that if they called the police, they were going to come back and hurt them.

Manthe said that he thought the suspects had given him a broken nose, so he went to Boone Hospital ER on 4/18/2014. He said he was advised at the emergency room that he did not have any fractures from the robbery.

I advised Sergeant Jason Jones of the incident.

Please forward this to Major Crimes. This report is open/active. Nothing further.
