INCIDENT NARRATIVE

S.H ARRESTED FOR DRIVING WHILE REVOKED AND NARCOTIC
DRUG LAW VIOLATIONS IN THE 1900 BLOCK OF WALCOTT ON
06/21/2014 AT APPROXIMATLY 2112 HOURS.

On 06/21/2014, at approximately 2112 hours, I was on routine patrol in the 1100 block of Vandiver. I was sitting on the parking lot of the Joe Machens car dealership observing the residence of 1125 Vandiver Drive. This address is a known place of prostitution and a known drug house. Sitting in the driveway of this residence was a 2004 Chrysler Concord bearing Missouri registration CJ4-D7N. I ran this registration on my Mobile Data Terminal and found that this registration checked to a Jeep; however, it was displayed on a Chrysler.

As I was observing the house, I witnessed a black female wearing a red top exit the front door of the residence, proceed to the driver's side of the vehicle, get in and back out of the driveway onto Vandiver. The driver then parked the vehicle in the center turn lane of Vandiver and appeared to be conversing through the passenger window over the lane of traffic to a subject I recognized in the front yard of the residence as Barry Manthe. Manthe and another black female, later identified as Dehavalyn Currie, entered Manthe's vehicle, a 1997 Chevy passenger car bearing Missouri registration PAW-NK4, and backed out onto Vandiver behind the Chrysler.

I then turned on my headlights and proceeded to the exit of the parking lot. At this time, I believe the driver of the Chrysler saw that I was pulling onto Vandiver and proceeded to make a turn two houses away from 1125 Vandiver to travel north bound on Wolcott. It should be noted that Wolcott is a dead end street and there are only several residences behind it. The Chevy passenger

car driven by Manthe turned in behind the Chrysler.

Near the dead end of Wolcott (1911 Wolcott), I saw the red Chrysler parked in the driveway with Manthe's vehicle behind it. I pulled in behind Manthe's vehicle and activated my overhead lights to investigate the suspicious behavior. I exited my vehicle and walked up to Manthe's car and saw a subject in the rear passenger seat who I identified through prior police contact as Shalmar Holden-Wilkerson. Holden-Wilkerson was also wearing a red top, consistent in appearance with the subject I witnessed driving the Chrysler. I also knew through prior police contact that Holden-Wilkerson was a revoked driver.

I asked Holden-Wilkerson to step out of the vehicle and talk to me near the front of my patrol vehicle. I asked Holden-Wilkerson if she was the one driving the car and she stated she was not. Holden-Wilkerson first stated that she was never in the red Chrysler and then later stated she was in the Chrysler, but it was driven by a friend of hers. I asked where this friend was and she stated inside the house at 1911 Wolcott. I detained Holden-Wilkerson in the rear of my patrol vehicle and I went and made contact with Manthe and the front seat passenger, Currie.

Manthe stated that he was giving Currie a ride and was leaving the residence at 1125 Vandiver at the same time as Holden-Wilkerson. Manthe stated that Holden-Wilkerson pulled out and then told him to follow her. Manthe stated that he followed Wilkerson to 1911 Wolcott, where she exited the Chrysler and entered the rear seat of his vehicle. Manthe stated there were no other subjects besides Holden-Wilkerson in the red Chrysler.

I made contact with Currie and Currie stated that Holden-Wilkerson was driving the red Chrysler. I attempted to question Currie further about her relationship with Manthe and Holden-Wilkerson and she stated that Manthe was giving her a ride to her boyfriend's house. I asked Currie what her boyfriend's name was and she stated his name was Tony, but she did not know his last name. I asked Currie where Tony lived and she stated she was unsure, due to the fact she had just moved to Columbia from Texas. Currie gave consent for officers to search her person and her belongings in the vehicle and no contraband was found.

Due to the fact that I saw a subject matching the clothing description of Holden-Wilkerson get into the red Chrysler and the fact I saw no other subject enter the Chrysler besides the driver, as well as Manthe and Currie's statements that Holden-Wilkerson was the driver, I placed Holden-Wilkerson under arrest for Driving While Revoked. I secured her into handcuffs and placed her in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

I then made contact with the resident of 1911 Wolcott, who had exited his home

to ascertain what was going on. I asked the resident, identified as John Thompson, if anybody had come into his house in the past several minutes. Thompson stated that no one had come to his house and he had been home alone. Thompson stated that he does not know Barry Manthe, Dehavalyn Currie, or Shalmar Holden-Wilkerson. Thompson stated that the Chrysler does not belong at that address and he has no knowledge of its owner or whose vehicle it is. Thompson requested that we tow the vehicle or get the vehicle moved at the conclusion of our investigation.

I then made contact with Holden-Wilkerson and read her the Miranda Warning off my department-issued Miranda Card. Holden-Wilkerson stated that she understood her rights and was willing to speak with me. Holden-Wilkerson stated that the vehicle was hers and it had been given to her by a friend of hers that owns a car dealership. Holden-Wilkerson stated the plates were given to her by a friend of hers from when she went to prison. It should also be noted when I originally asked Holden-Wilkerson for her ID, she got out of Manthe's vehicle and preceded to the front seat of the Chrysler to obtain her ID from her purse, which was sitting on the driver's seat.

I then released Manthe and Currie from the scene. After Manthe was released from the scene, Holden-Wilkerson stated that the keys to the vehicle were left in Manthe's car. I responded to the Chrysler to retrieve Holden-Wilkerson's purse prior to transport to CPD for the charge of Driving While Revoked. As I grabbed the purse, on top of the items in her purse was a spoon. On top of the spoon was a small piece of cotton swab or possibly the end of a Q-tip with residue on it. I immediately recognized this spoon as elicit paraphernalia and seized the item as evidence. Incident to finding the spoon, the rest of the vehicle and contents of Holden-Wilkerson's purse were examined. Inside of her purse, another spoon with residue was found. Both spoons field tested positive for methamphetamines.

Holden-Wilkerson was transported to the Columbia Police Department and the vehicle was towed. Upon arrival to CPD, the contents of Holden-Wilkerson's purse were further examined and inventoried according to policy and procedure. Holden-Wilkerson's purse contained a variety of miscellaneous paper items. One of these papers was a magazine page that had been folded over several times. As I examined the papers, I unfolded each one, knowing that it is common practice for drug users to conceal narcotics inside of folded paper. Inside of this magazine page was a white powdery substance. This powdery substance was consistent in appearance with powder cocaine. The substance later field tested positive for cocaine.

Holden-Wilkerson was then booked and processed according to procedure on the following charges:

- }1. violation of RSMo.302.321, Operating a Motor Vehicle on a Highway While License is Revoked
- }2. violation of RSMo.195.202F, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Felony
- }3. violation of RSMo.195.233M, Use/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Holden-Wilkerson was allowed to make phone calls and was transported to the Boone County Jail, where she was released into their custody in lieu of \$5,500.00 bond.

I consider this case to be cleared with an arrest and I request a copy of this report be forwarded to the State Prosecutor for their review.
