NARRATIVE:

On 1-1-91, I received a MULES NCIC teletype advising me that a German type 9mm luger with serial number 3505 was stolen. I obtained this information after checking the pawn shop tickets with the Paris Road Pawn Shop which indicated that it was sold to the Paris Road Pawn Shop on 12-3-90 for \$250. The person who sold/loaned the gun produced identification indicating the he was Barry P. Manthe. On this same date at approximately 11 am I went to the Paris Road Pawn Shop and confiscated the 9mm pistol and had a teletype sent to Portland PD indicating that the gun was possibly recovered and that I needed additional information on the original report which shows a date of theft of 8-25-86.

NARRATIVE:

On 02-04-91 I made contact with Portland, Oregon property detective Jim HOPE. Detective Hope advised me that the only additional information he had was that engraved on the pistol were the letters "DUM" and "1915". I then inspected the 9mm handgun which I recovered from the Paris Road Pawn Shop and I could not find those 3 letters or 4 numbers on it anywhere. Detective Hope advised me to disregard on this weapon since it is only a 4 digit serial number and I should consider it not stolen.

On this same date I removed the document and pistol along with the brown case and 2 empty magazines from evidence at the Columbia Police Department and brought it to the Paris Road Pawn Shop where I released it to employee, Westley SIMS. Westley SIMS signed the property receipt which was returned back to evidence and a copy was made for my file.

This officer recommends this case be cleared due to it being unfounded.
