On 11-05-96 at about 9 AM, I was sent to the Super 7 Motel, Room #129, in regard to this report. When I arrived I was contacted by Michael Martin. Mr. Martin reported that he woke up this morning about 7 PM and at 8 AM he looked out the window and saw that his rental car was missing. He said he checked with management and they had not towed the vehicle. He said he suspects a black male that he let in his room last night as being involved in the theft of his car. Martin said that he allowed a black male, about 5'9" tall with dreadlocks in his hair into his room last night about 9:30 PM. He said the subject told him that he had been locked out of room #202 at the motel and that he needed to call the room, using his telephone. Martin said that the subject made a phone call and did actually appear to be speaking to someone and that the subject left the room.

Martin told me that he had discovered his vehicle missing and noted that his keys were missing out of his room. He said that he then went to the motel management and found that room #202 had been rented to a Barry Manthe. Martin said that he learned that Barry Manthe's home address was 1203 Jefferson here in Columbia. He also had a telephone # of \_\_\_\_\_ He said he went to Barry Manthe's residence and that Barry Manthe "got really nervous". He said that he described the black male that had entered his room last night to Barry Manthe and Manthe told him that that sounded like Eric Cureton. He said Cureton is the current boyfriend of his ex-wife, Donna Brown. He said Manthe told him that Donna Brown and Eric Cureton were currently staying in room #127 which is immediately next door to the victim's room.

I advised Martin that Barry Manthe was a known procurer of prostitutes and that Donna Brown was a known prostitute. I had Martin tell me his story one more time and it did appear that Martin could possibly be somewhat confused or embarrassed about certain aspects of the story.

The missing vehicle was described as a maroon 1996 Dodge Intrepid 4 door with Illinois License Plates, \_\_\_\_\_ on it. Martin said he had rented the vehicle from Dollar Automobile Rentals at the Kansas City International Airport. He said he had rented the vehicle for a week and that he had flown to KCI from his home in Orlando, Florida to come visit family for vacation. He said he stayed in a motel room instead of with his uncle, Bud Bernett, who lives in a mobil home court here in Columbia.

While I was in Martin's room he received a telephone call from a subject identifying himself as Barry Manthe. I spoke with Manthe and Manthe advised that Eric Cureton had done this type of thing before with other rental vehicles. He said that if he finds out where the vehicle is, that he will let me know.

I provided Martin with a business card and obtained a phone # for Bud Bernett

as . He stated he would be staying at his Uncle Bud's for awhile and would be expecting to hear from me. I checked several different locations in central Columbia though was not able to locate the vehicle. I will be forwarding this case to Crimes Against Property Investigators for further follow up. I asked Joint to broadcast a STOP & HOLD on the vehicle and the name and physical description of both of the possible suspects including Cureton and Donna Brown. During my conversation with Manthe he advised that Donna Brown was with Cureton and that he was sure they were together.

I forwarded the necessary documents to Joint Communications to have the vehicle entered into MULES/NCIC as Stolen. I did make telephone contact with the Dollar Automobile Rental Agency at Kansas City International Airport. I did report to them that the vehicle has been reported stolen and they asked to be considered the victim in the theft and have the vehicle returned to them if it is located after the rental agreement has expired in the next several days.

On the date of 11-05-96, at approximately 22:30 hours, I overheard Officer HAWKINS's traffic in reference to a possible stolen vehicle located on Washington Street. He stated he had just passed a burgundy four door Dodge Intrepid with Illinois plate, . Officer HAWKINS asked for assistance. Earlier in the shift during briefing, we had been advised this vehicle had been stolen and that we were to concentrate our efforts on locating the vehicle.

At that time, Officers responded to the area of Dysart and Washington to attempt to recover the vehicle. After setting up, we learned that the vehicle had already departed before we were able to set up our perimeter. At that time, Officers cleared and attempted to find the vehicle. At approximately 23:12 hours, Officer Gerald GREENE stated he had located the vehicle in the Trinity and Switzler area. He stated he had seen it and it was traveling at a high rate of speed and he had lost him. At that time, I responded to the area and located the vehicle parked in the driveway of 323 Trinity. I ran the license plate , Illinois, and it was confirmed stolen out of Columbia Police Departments jurisdiction. At that time, Officers set up a perimeter on the vehicle and Officer Mitch BAXLEY was able to enter a housing authority unit with Housing Authority Officer SAM WILLIAMS and start surveillance on the vehicle.

After approximately two and one half hours of surveillance, Officer Jerry GREENE who had located the vehicle a second time, decided we needed to secure the vehicle, at which time we responded to 323 Trinity. While there, I secured the vehicle, while they went to the location of 323 Trinity and made contact with the residents there. I asked for an evidence tech, and Officer Bob BROWN of the Columbia Police Department was dispatched to my location. I also asked for a wrecker and J.P. Perry's responded. Officer BROWN took pictures of the vehicle at the scene and asked for the vehicle to be transported to the Columbia Police Department per permission from Sgt. Mike MARTIN for processing. This was due to the fact there was a large amount of prints that was visible on the windshield, mirrors and windows.

While conducting the investigation and securing the vehicle at the location of 323 Trinity, Officer HAWKINS, Officer Mitch BAXLEY and Officer Gerald GREENE was able to determine further information on the whereabouts of the driver that they had seen earlier in the vehicle. At that time, they

responded to an address south of our location, which I am not aware of. At that time, they came walking back with two subjects, who I do not know who they are, and advised me these subjects had been in the vehicle. At that time, I cleared and responded to the Columbia Police Department. At the Columbia Police Department, I notified acting supervisor, Sgt. Mike MARTIN.

At this time, he completed the appropriate Columbia Police Department forms for recovering of a stolen vehicle in our jurisdiction. He then had me notify Dollar Rental Car, when I spoke to a KEN JACOBI of Dollar Rent a Car in the Chicago O'Hare Airport, Chicago, Illinois. I advised Mr. JACOBI of the situation and of the vehicle we recovered. Mr. JACOBI stated the vehicle was not actually one of theirs, that it belonged to Dollar Rent a Car in Kansas City, Missouri, but that he would notify them in the morning, via telex. He stated they would be in contact with us. I gave Mr. JACOBI all pertinent information, including my name, badge number and telephone number of the Police Department, address and where the wrecker company was located and their telephone number.

At this time, I completed the NCIC clearance form and turned it over to Joint Communications to clear the stolen vehicle out of the computer. At this time, there is no further.

On 11-05-96, at approximately 22:43 hours, Officer Don HAWKINS was on routine patrol near the intersection of Washington and Wilkes. He had called in a registration on a maroon passenger vehicle. This registration was . It was registered to a 1996 Dodge Intrepid. The communications center advised him that this vehicle had been reported stolen.

As Officer HAWKINS tried to turn around and find the vehicle, he noted it was parked near the intersection of Wilkes and Washington. At that time, we set up a perimeter on the vehicle to see if the subjects would come back to it. Approximately 10 minutes later, we noted the vehicle had left, however, we were unable to see who was in it and where it went.

At approximately 23:19 hours, I was on routine patrol near the intersection of LaSalle and Switzler. I saw a maroon Dodge passenger vehicle turn onto Trinity. I was unable to get a registration, however, did fit the description that Officer HAWKINS had broadcast earlier. At that time, I tried to catch up with the vehicle, however, I lost it in the area. I had other officers try to find the vehicle as I knew that it had to be parked somewhere nearby. Officer Robert BENNETT had stated he saw the vehicle and the registration parked at 323 Trinity. At that time, myself and other Officers set up a perimeter to see if the driver would come back to it.

Myself and other Officers were in the area for approximately 3 1/2 hours waiting for someone to enter the vehicle and leave. At approximately 02:00 hours, myself and other officers decided to go ahead and make contact with the residents at 323 Trinity to tow the vehicle.

Upon arrival, myself and other officers knocked on the door at 323 Trinity and made contact with the residents. I was met at the door by a female subject who identified herself as GAYLE LOGAN. I asked Ms. LOGAN if she knew who owned the vehicle in her driveway, at which time, she stated she did not. I asked her if she was aware that the vehicle was in her driveway, at which time, she stated she didn't. She stated to me that she had arrived home at approximately 10:00 PM and the vehicle wasn't there when she got home.

While speaking with MS. LOGAN, I did recall that she had a son by the name of JISEOP LOGAN. I did remember over the weekend being at the Juvenile Justice Center and noting that JISEOP LOGAN had a pick up and detain order for him. I asked Ms. LOGAN if JISEOP was in the residence at which time, she stated he was, however, he was asleep. I asked her if I could speak with him, at which time, she did go to his room and had him come outside. I then asked JISEOP LOGAN if he was aware of the vehicle in the driveway, at which time, he stated he wasn't. I asked him if he had been inside the vehicle, and he stated he had not. I asked if he could associate anybody to the vehicle, at which time, he stated he knew a male subject who lived at 306 Trinity. He identified this subject only as JEROME.

I asked LOGAN if he was aware there was a pick up and detain order for him issued by the Boone County Juvenile Justice Center, at which time, he stated that he wasn't. I then called the Communications Center, at which time, they called the Juvenile Justice Center Office and stated the pick up order was active. I then told LOGAN there was an active pick up order for him, at which time, I placed handcuffs on him and stated he was under arrest in reference to this pick up order. I then placed him in the back seat of my patrol car, #1159.

At that time, myself and Officer Don HAWKINS and Officer Mitch BAXLEY went to 306 Trinity to see if a male subject by the name of JEROME lived there. We knocked on the door and was met by a female subject. I asked if JEROME was in the residence, at which time, he stated he was. I asked if I could speak with him, at which time, she went back to his room. She came back and stated she was unable to wake him up. I asked if I could come in and speak to him, at which time, she stated that I could. I then went to the back bedroom, where I noted a male subject on the bed, later identified as JEROME BUTLER. I was able to wake him up and stated to him that I was investigating the vehicle in front of the LOGAN residence, located at 323 Trinity. I asked if he was aware of this vehicle, at which time, he stated he was. I inquired with him if he had been in the vehicle, earlier in the evening, at which time, he stated he had been. I asked him if he could elaborate on what occurred, at which time, he stated to me he had received the vehicle from a male subject, who he only knew as ERIC.

He stated at approximately 10:00 or 11:00 PM, he went to the McDonalds Restaurant on Business Loop 70, in order to get some food for GAYLE LOGAN. He went on to state that he continued to drive around, when he noted there were police cars trying to follow him. He stated he got very nervous about it and at that time, he pulled into the driveway of the LOGAN residence and left the car. I asked if there was anyone with him, at which time, he stated that he had a friend by the name of CARLOS. I asked where CARLOS was at which time he stated that he did not know. I asked where he lived, at which time, he told me

that CARLOS lived in the Indian Hills Subdivision.

Officer HAWKINS was present with me while speaking with BUTLER in the bedroom. Officer HAWKINS had stated to me that he identified BUTLER as the one who was driving the vehicle earlier, when he had spotted it. At that time, I advised BUTLER that he was under arrest for Auto Tampering and placed handcuffs on him. While escorting him to the front door, we noted a male subject asleep on the couch. I asked BUTLER if the male subject on the couch was CARLOS, at which time, he stated he was. Officer HAWKINS had a conversation with CARLOS at that time. For pertinent details see his supplement report. Subsequently, CARLOS THOMPSON was arrested for Tampering in the 2nd Degree. Both subjects were then transported to the Columbia Police Department for processing.

Once at the Police Department, I met with BUTLER once more and escorted him to an interview room and read him his miranda rights. I asked him if he was willing to answer questions in reference to the vehicle, at which time, he stated to me he did not want to answer any questions. At that time, I escorted him back to his holding cell. BUTLER was photographed, fingerprinted and processed under the Columbia Police Department policy, at which time, he was transported to the Boone County Jail by a third shift officer.

On 11-05-96 at approximately 10:43 PM, I was on patrol southbound on Providence approaching the intersection at Park Avenue. At this time, I observed a newer model maroon colored four-door Dodge Intrepid that had an Illinois registration of . At this time, I then ran the registration through the Department of Revenue and I was advised by Joint Communications that the vehicle had been reported stolen earlier in the day here in Columbia, Missouri.

As I passed by the vehicle, I observed that it was occupied by two unidentified black males although I did have a clear and unobstructed view of the driver of the vehicle. As I passed the Dodge traveling in a southbound direction, I observed it to make a left-hand turn from Park Avenue onto Providence, at which time it began traveling in a northbound direction.

Upon turning my patrol vehicle around, I attempted to pull in behind the Dodge Intrepid and I observed that it made a right-hand turn from Providence onto Rogers and began traveling in an eastbound direction. I also observed the Dodge Intrepid to make a left-hand turn from Rogers onto Fifth Street, at which time it began traveling toward the intersection at Hickman. At this time, I then momentarily lost sight of the vehicle and I would eventually relocate it parked unoccupied in a northbound direction on Washington just north of Hickman.

Upon locating the vehicle, I contacted other officers in the area in an attempt to "set up" on the Dodge Intrepid in the hopes that the occupants would return to it. Before additional officers could arrive on the scene, the original occupants apparently returned to the vehicle and drove away from the scene without being seen.

On 11-05-96 at approximately 11:12 PM, I assisted Officer Gerald Greene, who had once again located the Dodge Intrepid parked in the driveway at 323

Trinity. Upon arriving at the scene, I was informed by Officer Greene that the vehicle was unoccupied, and that officers were once again attempting to surround the immediate area in the hope that the occupants would once again return to the vehicle.

On 11-06-96 at approximately 2:21 AM, I was advised by Officer Greene that he was going to recover the vehicle in the driveway and attempt to contact the residents at 323 Trinity in the hope of determining who had been in possession of the vehicle. At this time, myself and Officer Greene made contact with an individual known to us as JISEOP LOGAN. Logan would inform Officer Greene that an individual known to him only as JEROME was responsible for the vehicle. Logan would state to Officer Greene that Jerome had driven the vehicle to this location earlier in the evening and had been walked to 306 Trinity.

At this time, myself and Officer Greene then responded to 306 Trinity and made contact with an individual who then led us to a JAMES JEROME BUTLER who was asleep in one of the back bedrooms. This officer would then overhear a conversation between Officer Greene and James Jerome Butler in reference to the stolen Dodge Intrepid. Jerome or James would state to Officer Greene that he had been driving the vehicle earlier in the evening, and that his friend, CARLOS, had been a passenger in the vehicle at this time. James or Jerome then identified the passenger in his vehicle as CARLOS DWAYNE THOMPSON. James or Jerome Butler then identified Carlos Thompson as being the individual sleeping on the couch in the living room.

At this time, I then contacted Thompson in the living room and informed him that he was under arrest for second degree tampering or joyriding, and I placed him into handcuffs.

Thompson was transported from the scene of the arrest to the Columbia Police Department for processing and interviewing. Upon arriving at the Columbia Police Department, I proceeded to read Carlos Thompson his Miranda Rights at approximately 3:36 AM and he stated that he understood his Rights. At this time, I then asked Thompson if he wished to make a statement in reference to the stolen vehicle and he gave the following account:

Thompson stated that on 11-05-96 sometime around 9:45 PM, he was walking in the area of Trinity and Switzler. Thompson stated that at this time a friend of his by the name of Jerome or James Butler then drove up in a red Dodge Intrepid. Thompson stated that he had never seen Butler in this car before nor had he ever seen the vehicle itself before. Thompson stated that as far as he knew, Butler owned an older model Delta 88. Thompson stated that Butler stopped the vehicle and offered him a ride and he accepted. Thompson stated that he and Butler did not have plans to get together this evening, and that it was a chance meeting.

Thompson stated that he did not ask Butler where he got the car nor did he care. Thompson stated that he and Butler then "just went riding around" and were "doing nothing in particular." Thompson stated that he and Butler drove around for approximately thirty minutes when they came to a stop on Park Avenue at Providence. Thompson stated that at this time they then saw a police vehicle traveling southbound on Providence toward their location. Thompson stated that both he and Butler observed the police officer looking at them and their vehicle, and that they became nervous.

Thompson would not state why he or Butler were nervous, although he did state they decided to go in the opposite direction that the police officer was going. Thompson stated that Butler then made a left-hand turn from Park Avenue onto Providence. Thompson stated that as they were traveling on Providence toward Rogers Street, they observed the police officer turn his patrol vehicle around and begin following them. Thompson stated that Butler then made a right-hand turn from Providence onto Rogers in an attempt to avoid the police.

Thompson stated that upon coming to Fifth Street that Butler made a left-hand turn and began traveling toward Hickman. Thompson stated that when they traveled through the Hickman and Washington intersection, they noticed that the police were still behind them although they weren't very close. Thompson stated that he and Butler decided to pull the car over to the side of the road and exit it before the police attempted to stop them. Thompson stated that he and Butler then stopped the car and exited it, at which time they walked around the corner. Thompson stated that they watched the police officer for several minutes, and that when he drove past their vehicle they returned to it immediately.

Thompson stated that he and Butler then got into the vehicle and made a U-turn on Washington and began traveling back toward Trinity. Thompson stated that at this time he was once again a passenger of the vehicle as Butler was driving the Dodge. Thompson stated that after they avoided the police, they then drove around town and went to both McDonald's and the Breaktime on Providence before they parked the vehicle at 323 Trinity. Thompson stated that after parking the vehicle that he and Butler then went to 306 Trinity where they planned on spending the evening or morning.

Thompson would make no other statements in reference to this incident.

On 11-05-96, at approximately 23:12 hours, I went to the area of 323 Trinity to assist other officers in the recovery of a stolen vehicle. Upon my arrival in the area, I observed a maroon in color four door Dodge Intrepid, bearing Illinois registration , parked in the driveway of 323 Trinity, which was located on the eastside of the residence.

At this time, I then went into an empty unit with Columbia Housing Authority Security Officer SAM WILLIAMS, so that I could observe anyone getting into the vehicle and driving off. While watching this vehicle, I observed several subjects coming out of 323 Trinity and getting into the stolen vehicle for short periods of time, and would then leave the car and go back inside the residence. These subjects would also get into the vehicle and walk south on Trinity to what appeared to be 306 Trinity.

On 11-06-96, at approximately 02:21 hours, Officer GREENE stated that he was no longer going to wait to see if anyone would drive off in it and that he was going to recover the vehicle. While at 323 Trinity, GREENE made contact with an individual as JISEOP LOGAN, who informed Officer GREENE that an individual known to him only as JEROME had driven the car to this location and had gone to 306 Trinity.
