TIME ELEMENT:

This burglary occurred between 07/11/2006 at 1900 hours and 07/12/2006 at 1300 hours.

CRIME SCENE PROCESSING:

I took photographs of the interior and exterior of storage unit #13. I dusted for fingerprints, but was unable to recover any latent prints. A canvass of the area was not done because there were no individuals in the immediate area of the burglary scene.

M.O.:

It appears the suspect(s) beat the padlock off the storage unit door and proceeded to pry into the door lock area. The suspect(s) were able to pull the door opened, where it became stuck approximately 2 feet off the ground. The suspect(s) took the majority of the the items in the storage unit #13, but left a few small items behind. The storage unit faces Creasy Springs road, in

a commercial area.

STOLEN PROPERTY:

Stolen property includes one blue Sapphire 14 carat gold ring with 24 diamonds surrounding it (approximately one karat total) and valued at \$750. Two thousand dollars in cash in assorted denominations. The victim stated there were other personal items inside the storage, but refused to go into depth on what those items were.

SUSPECT INFORMATION:

The victim advised an individual who works for A-1 Taxi, by the name of J. W., dropped him off at his storage unit recently. The victim described "J.W." as a white heavy set male, who has a crack habit. The victim stated "J.W." has since been fired from an A-1 Taxi.

EVIDENCE RECOVERED:

One roll of film, consisting of pictures taken at the scene was recovered.

WITNESS INFORMATION:

There is no current witness information at this time.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

On 07/12/2006 at 1612 hours, Joint Communications advised me of a burglary at 1410 Creasy Springs, Cosmos Self Storage. Joint Communications advised the door to storage unit #13, was broken into with items stolen.

Upon arrival at the Columbia Police Department, I made telephone contact with the complainant, Andrew Anderson. Anderson advised he is the owner of Cosmos Self Storage. Anderson advised Unit 13 was broken into between 07/11/2006 at 1900 hours and 07/12/2006 at 1300 hours. Anderson advised we should contact the storage unit owner, identified as Barry Manthe for further information.

I made telephone contact with Manthe, who advised he had not seen his storage unit since approximately 07/05/2006 at 1900 hours. Manthe stated he was advised by Anderson his storage unit was broken into. Manthe advised

items stolen were as listed:

1. A blue Sapphire 14 carat gold ring with 24 diamonds around the stone (approximately 1 karat, valued at \$750.
2. Two Thousand Dollars in cash,
3. Personal items (Manthe would not go into details as to what those personal items were).

I asked Manthe if he had any possible suspect information and he advised an individual who used to work for A-1 Taxi, identified as "J.W. dropped Manthe off at his storage unit recently. Manthe described "J.W." as a white heavy set male with a crack habit dropped him off at his storage unit recently. Manthe advised he believed "J.W." could be a possible person of interest. Manthe was given a case number and I responded to the storage unit to process the scene.

Upon arrival at 1410 Creasy Springs Road, I took photographs of the interior and exterior of the storage unit #13. Upon looking at the storage unit, I observed the metal roll up door was damaged near the lock area. Upon looking at the door latch, it appears the suspect(s) beat off the pad lock and did a moderate amount of damage to the steel door. It appears the suspect(s) opened the door approximately two feet off the ground where it was jammed in the door rail. The pad lock was later given to me by Anderson. Upon looking at the pad lock, I observed damage to the top of the pad lock, consistent with someone hitting it with a hard instrument. Anderson advised the value of the roll up door damaged was valued at approximately \$45. Upon looking inside the storage unit, I observed a few items on the ground, which the suspect(s) left behind. While at the storage unit I dusted for prints, but was unable to recover any latent fingerprints. A canvass of the area was not done, due to no houses or individuals in the area.

Anderson and Manthe were given case numbers and a roll of film was recovered at the scene. Items entered into Evidence include the roll of film. This case should be rated to the Major Crimes Division in reference the possible person of interest.

Nothing further.
