On 9/9/10, Officer Kevin Moroney and I were in the area of Rangeline and Blue Ridge when we observed a vehicle traveling in front of us identified as a gold 2002 Buick Century bearing Wisconsin registration 679PMN. We observed the vehicle did not have an operable brake light on the passenger side. We conducted a traffic stop with the vehicle on Rangeline near Elleta.

Officer Kevin Moroney made contact with the driver identified as Barry

Manthe, while I made contact with the passenger. The passenger identified herself as Brooke Barker (DOB: 8/6/78, SS# 440452422). After advising the individuals the reason for the stop, we ran them through Communications. It was determined the passenger was actually identified as Brooke Troutt who had an active warrant for her arrest. Brooke was taken into custody for the warrant and Manthe was given a warning for his defective equipment. Troutt was adamant that she wished to leave her purse with Manthe, however, Manthe did not wish to keep her purse with him in his vehicle. We took the purse so we could place it in Troutt's property. Once the warrant was confirmed, Troutt was transported to the Columbia Police Department for processing.

Upon arrival at the Columbia Police Department, Troutt was placed in a holding cell. I inventoried Troutt's purse, located a clear plastic baggie containing a white, powdery residue inside. I tested the substance for cocaine, however, it did not come back as positive for the presence of cocaine. I believe this substance is possibly a prescription medication due to information I've received about Troutt. The baggie will be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol lab for analysis.

While processing Troutt, she was mirandized using a printed miranda card. Troutt stated she understood her rights and wished to speak with me. Troutt stated she is not prescribed any medications currently. Troutt further stated she didn't know what the substance was in the baggie. Troutt advised the baggie could have been left in her purse from years ago. When the baggie was located, it was in a location that was readily visible.

Troutt was processed by taking her fingerprints and photographs for a Felony State Warrant #09BUCR0173601 issued on 9/1/10 out of SO Buchanan County-St. Joseph for the original charge of fraudulently attempting to obtain a controlled substance with a \$40,000 bond. After processing, Troutt was placed in a holding cell to await transportation to the Boone County Jail.

This report should be routed to the State Prosecutor's Office. The baggie was placed into Evidence at the Columbia Police Department and sent for analysis.
