On 12/10/2010 at approximately 21:21 hours, I responded to 212A Providence Walkway in reference to an assault. Joint Communications advised the complainant was cut by a subject armed with a knife at a different location.

Upon arrival, I was assisted by Officer Clint Sinclair. We made contact with the complainant, identified as Tiffany Cook. Cook advised she was assaulted around 20:45 hours at 1125 Vandiver Drive by a subject later identified as Ronald Clark. Cook advised she went to 1125 Vandiver in order to "rescue" her friend, identified as Iris Faheem. Cook further advised Clark runs "a hoe house" out of the Vandiver location and that Faheem is a working girl there. Cook further advised there is a lot of illegal drug use going on at the residence as well and she felt she needed to "rescue" Faheem from the house.

Cook stated when she arrived at the house, Clark started yelling at her, accusing her of telling the police about his prostitution operation. Cook stated she and Clark got in a physical altercation and that Clark cut her finger with a small kitchen knife. Cook said she was then "held back" by Faheem, because she was trying to strike Clark. Cook stated she wanted Clark arrested for cutting her.

I observed the injury to Cook's right index finger and noted it did not appear consistent with an injury caused by a bladed instrument. I observed a small piece of skin to be torn back, more consistent with an abrasion or a burn. I photographed Cook's injury with my digital camera. Cook did not complain of any other injury while officer Sinclair and I were speaking with her.

While speaking with Cook, I noted her speech was broken and she appeared to have difficulty putting complete sentences together. Cook constantly repeated what she was telling me, and would randomly go off on tangents about matters not related to the alleged assault. I believed at the time Cook was likely under the influence of either alcohol, drugs or a combination thereof.

Officer Sinclair and I responded to 1125 Vandiver Drive where I made contact with Ronald Clark, Iris Faheem, and another female subject identified as Stephanie Ray. Clark stated Cook arrived at his residence unannounced and immediately began to cause a scene. Clark advised Cook shoved him in an attempt to get past him and to Faheem. Clark advised there was a brief physical altercation between himself and Cook, but Faheem pulled Cook back and drug her out of the house. Clark advised he did not wish to press assault charges against Cook, but he did want her trespassed from his residence.

Iris Faheem also said Cook was acting strangely and that she was trying to fight with Clark. Faheem advised she grabbed hold of Cook and began pulling

her out the front door of the residence. Faheem stated Cook grabbed the door frame and that it was likely she sustained the finger injury during the struggle. Faheem stated Clark did not have a knife or attempt to hurt Cook with a knife.

Stephanie Ray stated she was also present during the altercation, but she said she did not become involved. Ray stated she could tell Cook was very upset because she was yelling and screaming and trying to hit Clark with her fists. Ray stated Faheem was able to get Cook out of the house and she assumed Cook then left the area.

Based on the statements of Clark and the two witness, I determine Cook was not assaulted by Clark as she had claimed. Officer Sinclair and I went back to Cook's apartment to issue a trespass warning for Clark's residence. While enroute, I was advised by Joint Communications that Cook had been calling 911 multiple times since I left her apartment and was yelling at the operators.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Cook at her apartment and advised her I would not be making an arrest on this case. I also issued a verbal trespass warning to Cook for 1125 Vandiver Drive, which she stated she understood. I also advised Cook to stop calling 911 in reference to this incident because it was not an emergency. Cook stated she understood and Officer Sinclair and I began walking to our patrol cars.

Before making it to the parking lot, I was advised by Joint Communications Cook had just called back on 911 again. Officer Sinclair and I responded back to Cook's apartment and knocked on the door. It was my intent to arrest Cook for misuse of emergency telephone services, because she called 911 at least seven (7) different times (according to Joint Communications) regarding the same non-emergency incident. Cook would not come to the door and then began to yell and scream from the open, top floor window of her apartment. Cook first yelled profanity at officers and then began to "rap" various unintelligible sentences. Cook continued yell loudly, draw the attention of several neighbors who began to come out of their apartments. I also observed Cook's four-year-old daughter, identified as Kayoina Lilly, to be present in the apartment with Cook. From my vantage point, it did not appear Lilly was in danger of being harmed by Cook.

I requested the assistance of another officer and the Columbia Housing Authority to help with Cook. I was assisted by Officer Julie Marty and two member of the Housing Authority. Cook was asked if we could come into her apartment and she yelled, "yeah, come on up". One of the Housing Authority officer unlocked Cook's door at the same time Cook opened it herself. I immediately took hold of Cook and secured her in handcuffs. As I was placing handcuffs on Cook, I observed her spit saliva on to Officer Sinclair. Cook was

told she was now receiving an additional charge of 3rd degree assault on a law enforcement officer. Officer Marty turned over custody of Kayoina Lilly to Cook's neighbor, identified as Gaynel Bradford. Bradford told me earlier she would care for Lilly while Cook was in police custody, and that she often babysits Lilly for Cook during the week.

Officer Sinclair and I led Cook towards my patrol car, she began to drag her feet and I employed a transport wrist lock which was effective at getting Cook to move under her own power. Cook was searched by my patrol car and continued to yell and curse at Office Sinclair and I. I located nothing of evidentiary value on Cook's person. Officer Sinclair and I instructed Cook to get into the back seat of the patrol car, but she refused, saying "fuck your police car!", among other unintelligible screaming. Officer Sinclair and I forced Cook into the rear seat and closed the doors. Cook immediately began to kick the security bars over the windows and continued to scream and curse.

I removed Cook from the back seat and called for an officer to bring a pair of leg restraints to the scene. While waiting for the leg restraints, Cook attempted to turn her head and spit towards my face. I avoided the spit, and held Cook's head down on the trunk of my patrol car to prevent her from spitting on me or any other officers. Cook began to complain of pain to her lip, and that she could feel blood in her mouth. Once the officer with leg restraints arrived, they were secured on Cook's ankles and Cook was placed face down in the rear seat of my patrol car. I secured a second pair of handcuffs between the chain links of the first pair of cuffs and the links of the leg restraints, effectively immobilizing Cook in the back seat.

I transported Cook to the Columbia Police Department for processing and requested a medic unit to meet me at CPD in reference to Cook's complaint of lip pain. When I pulled into the sally port, Cook sat up and spit multiple times on the window glass of my patrol car. Cook was removed from the patrol car and carried to a holding cell, where she was secured to a ring. Upon arrival of medical personnel, Cook was uncooperative and would not show the medics her alledged lip injury. I closely observed Cook's mouth and did not see any indication of blood in her mouth.

Cook requested to go to the hospital and I transported her to the University of Missouri emergency room. While enroute to the hospital, Cook admitted to me she had smoked a Newport cigarette dipped in PCP earlier in the day. Based on my observations of Cook and my knowledge, training and experience, I believe Cook's behavior to be consistant with an individual under the influenc of PCP.

Cook was evaluated by medical staff and deemed to be medically sound. It should be noted Cook yelled and screamed and cursed at officers and hospital

staff while in their care, and she had to be restrained to the bed with handcuffs. After receiving Cook's discharge paper work, Cook was placed in a wheel chair to be moved out to my patrol car. Without warning, Cook looked up and spit directly into my face. I informed Cook she just recieved a second count of 3rd degree assault on law enforcement.

Cook was transported back to the Columbia Police Department and processed for the following:

- 1) Misuse of Emergency Telephone Service
In violation of RSMo 190.308 (M)
\$500.00 cash or surety bond
- 2) Third degree Assault of a Law Enforcement Officer
In violation of RSMo565.083 (M) 2 counts
\$1,000.00 cash or surety bond

Cook was processed without incident, but continued to yell and scream from her holding cell. Cook was left secured to the ring in her cell until transported to the Boone County Jail for further disposition of the charges.

Photographs taken of Cook have been entered into evidence at the Columbia Police Department. The patrol car video of the arrest has been tagged and entered into evidence via the video server.

This report should be forwarded to the state prosecutor for their review. For further information, please see Officer Sinclair's supplement under this case number.

The original allegation of assault is unfounded and this case is clear by arrest.

Nothing further.
