INCIDENT NARRATIVE

ON 01/27/2017 AT APPROXIMATELY 2315 HOURS, OFFICERS
RESPONDED TO THE 1100 BLOCK OF VANDIVER DRIVE IN
REFERENCE TO A ROBBERY WITH A GUN.

On 01/27/2017, at approximately 2315 hours, I was dispatched to 1125 Vandiver Drive, in reference to a burglary with a gun. While en route, Joint Communications advised that a caller had contacted 911 and reported multiple black subjects were on-scene and were currently robbing the house at that time. The caller advised he had reported seeing multiple guns, described as a possible .357 and Uzi. While speaking with the subject on the phone, operators advised a shot had been fired and there was a victim as a result of the incident, and advised the victim had been struck in the stomach.

Upon arrival, myself and Sergeant Meyer conducted a clear of the inside of the residence. No suspects were located throughout the check of the interior of the house. I assisted by interviewing multiple witnesses who had been present during the robbery. I spoke with them in reference to the incident.

I first witness I spoke with, James Jones, advised he had been at the residence to visit with a friend named Rebecca and advised he had arrived at approximately 2230 hours on 01/27/2017. Jones advised while inside the residence in a rear east bedroom he heard the sound of glass breaking somewhere inside the house, and advised a few minutes later a black male had broken down the door and stated, "where's the bread at, where's the fat man at?" Jones advised he handed over approximately one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in cash out of his wallet and gave it to the suspect at that time. Jones advised the suspect then ran out of the room and went back out of his view. Jones advised approximately two minutes later the suspect reentered the room and asked the female subject Rebecca who she was on the phone with. Jones advised the suspect grabbed the phone and threw it on the ground. Jones advised the suspect was last seen running out of the room way off from the rear bedroom area. Jones described the suspect as a black male, in his 20's, approximately 5'6" tall, weighing between 140 and 150 pounds, last seen wearing a dark colored hoodie. Jones advised he believed the suspect may have been holding a handgun, but could not provide a detailed description while speaking with him.

I spoke with another witness, Alan King. King advised he had arrived at the residence at approximately 2245 hours on 01/27/2017. King advised he had arrived and come to the residence in order to see a friend named Tana. King advised while hanging out in the front west bedroom inside the residence, Tana heard a knock at the door and advised she got up to go to the front of the residence. King advised he went to a bathroom located close to the bedroom area. King advised he heard loud knocking at the front door and heard two male voices he described as black males say, "get down, get down." King advised he heard two suspects running around the house demanding money from subjects inside the residence. King advised he opened the door to the bathroom and advised saw one suspect run towards him and told him to get on the floor. King advised he saw the suspect holding what he described as a dark colored handgun in his right hand, and advised the suspect told him to close his eyes and lay on the ground. King advised he complied and lay on the ground and kept his eyes closed throughout the incident. King advised he continued to hear the suspects move around throughout the house demanding money from other subjects, and advised he heard a single gunshot and advised he looked up and saw his friend, Tana, had been shot. King advised he last saw both suspects running out of the front area of the residence in an unknown direction. King advised he could not provide description of either suspect at that time upon my request.

The next witness I spoke with, Justin Dueber, in reference to the incident. Dueber advised he had gone to the residence at approximately 2145 hours on 01/27/2017 and had arrived looking to speak with his sister, Andrea Klatt, and advised upon arrival he was told by the residents that she was not there at that time. Dueber advised both he and a female friend who was present with him stayed at the residence and continued to hang out with the occupants inside. Dueber advised he went to a bathroom located on the north side of the house with his friend, Elizabeth, and advised both subjects were in the bathroom. Dueber advised a few minutes later, he heard loud banging at the front door of the residence and heard unknown subjects state, "bitch I ain't playing." Dueber advised both he and Elizabeth ran outside of the bathroom and attempted to run to a bedroom located on the west side of the residence in order to leave the residence, and advised was approached by a suspect that stated, "where's the bread?" Dueber advised he looked down at the ground and did not make eye contact with the suspect and also advised Elizabeth to do the same. Dueber advised he gave the suspect approximately forth-five dollars (\$45.00) in cash from his wallet at which time, the suspect advised both him and Elizabeth to go into the living room area and lay on the ground. Dueber advised while in the living room area he heard the suspects state "mother fuckers we are from Shy Town and we will kill you." and advised he heard approximately what he described as two gunshots. Dueber advised after the gunshots both suspects fled through the front area of the residence in an unknown direction. Dueber advised approximately 10 seconds later both he and Elizabeth got up from the

floor and advised they saw a subject was struck as a result of the gunshots that they had heard. Dueber advised both he and Elizabeth proceeded to exit the residence and advised they were met at the front area of the residence by officers.

I transported a witness who was on-scene, Rebecca Bushman, to the Columbia Police Department for continued questioning. I conducted a search of her person and her property and did not locate any illegal items of contraband before placing her in my marked patrol vehicle. Bushman was transported to the Columbia Police Department where she was interviewed by Detectives on-scene and later released with no further incident.

I have tagged and retained my Axon body camera footage for court.

I consider this case to be open/active at this time and request a copy of this case be forwarded to Major Crimes for their review.

For further information refer to the primary officer's report and all other supplemental reports.
