NARRATIVE

This narrative is a summary of the below incident. Please refer to body camera video for exact details.

On 01/27/2017, at approximately 2315 hours, I was dispatched to 1125 Vandiver Drive for a Robbery with a gun. Prior to arrival, I heard that a Boone County Sheriff's deputy was in pursuit with a vehilce that was leaving the scene.

I heard that the deputy had the vehicle stopped at Holly and Parker and that two suspects ran from the vehilce. I also heard that the deputy was in a foot pursuit with a suspect.

I continued to Holly and Parker to assist the deputy. When I arrived on scene at approximatley 2319 hours, I observed a gray Chevy Suburban, bearing Missouri Registration PP4H3K, pulled over with the front passenger door open. I exited my patrol car and noticed that the front drivers side door had cracked open, and I could see a black male subject, later identified as Anthony W. Hayes, sitting in the drivers seat.

Due to the nature of the call, I conducted a felony traffic stop with the vehicle and had Hayes exit the vehicle at gun point. Hayes was detained and placed into handcuffs without incident.

Myself and other officers cleared the vehicle for persons and weapons. No other individuals were located and no weapons were found.

I observed a baggie with several white rocks located on the side walk next to the front passenger door. Based on my training and experience I believed the white rocks were crack cocaine. I also observed a baggie with a green leafy substance sitting next to the curb, next to the front passenger side of the vehicle. Based on my training and experience, I believed the green leafy

substance to be Marijuana. While searching the vehicle, I also located two baggies containing Marijuana and another baggie containing crack rocks in the glove box.

I advised Hayes of his Miranda Rights while on scene at which time he agreed to speak with me. I asked him about the robbery that occurred on Vandiver and he told me that he did not know anything about the situation.

Hayes told me that earlier he and his wife were involved in a verbal altercation. He told me that he received a call from his friend "Jeremy". He said his friend asked him to meet at the corner of Blue Ridge Drive and Rangeline Road, near Colonial Village. He said he walked to the corner to meet with his friend "Jeremy". Hayes told me that he did not know Jeremy's last name.

Hayes told me that when he got to the vehicle, Jeremy had asked him to drive, since Hayes had a valid license. Hayes said he agreed to drive and that when he got into the vehicle, he observed another black male sitting in the back seat. He stated that he did not know the second individual, and described him as a black male, wearing a dark colored hoodie sweater. He stated that the unknown male, kept his hoodie pulled up so he could not see his face.

Hayes told me they left Colonial Village and headed south on Rangeline Road. He told me that they turned east on Vandiver Drive and he said he saw a patrol car go past him with its spot light on. He stated that he observed another patrol car go past him shortly after the first patrol car. Hayes stated that he turned north on Parker and when he looked in his review mirror he saw a patrol car with its overhead emergency lights on. He stated that he turned onto Holly and that when he went to pull over, his friend Jeremy and the unknown subject bailed from the vehicle and ran on foot. Hayes stated he stayed with the vehicle. I asked Hayes why the other two occupants ran and he stated that he did not know. I asked Hayes if he observed a gun on either of the two occupants and he told me "no".

I asked Hayes about the drugs found near and in the vehicle and he stated that he did not know about the drugs. He informed me that he was on parole and that if he knew about the robbery or the drugs he would have ran from the car.

Hayes asked me if I could call his wife, Shabonia Hayes, and let her know that he was in custody so she did not have to worry about him. I told him that I would. While on scene I contacted Shabonia and informed her that Anthony was detained and that he will be going to the Columbia Police Department to speak with detectives. I asked Shabonia if her and Anthony were involved in a verbal argument earlier and if Anthony left the house. She confirmed that they were involved in an argument and that Anthony did leave. She did not know if he left the residence on foot or by vehicle.

I transported Hayes to the Columbia Police Department for an interview with detectives. At approximately 0525 hours, I was informed by detectives that I could release Hayes due to not having probable cause for his arrest in connection with the Robbery.

I did not arrest Anthony Hayes for possession of drugs due. I believed he did not know the narcotics were in the vehicle, because he stayed on scene and did not run when he had the opportunity. Also no contraband was found on Hayes when he was searched.

Hayes had a cell phone on his person at the time of contact and the cell phone was turned over to detectives.

I secured the following items from the vehicle and placed them into evidence.


- 1) 9.58 grams of Marijuana
- 2) 3.96 grams of Marijuana
- 3) 12.33 grams of Marijuana
- 4) 10.21 grams of Marijuana
- 5) .77 grams of crack cocaine
- 6) 3.22 grams of crack cocaine
- 7) .40 grams of crack cocaine
- 8) .89 grams of crack cocaine

I field tested both the crack cocaine and marijuana. Both substances tested positive.


My AXON body camera and dash came video were tagged and are available for review.
