NARRATIVE

On 01/27/2017, at approximately 2312 hours, I overheard radio traffic in reference to a robbery with gun, with at least one gunshot victim, at 1125 Vandiver Drive. I proceeded to the area to assist with a perimeter. #931750

Shortly after my arrival, I responded to the 1800 Block of Holly Avenue to assist with a K9 track. According to radio traffic, a Boone County Sheriff's Deputy had located a suspect vehicle from the robbery and attempted to stop the vehicle. When the suspect vehicle eventually stopped, suspects fled from the vehicle on foot, prompting the K9 track.

As officers were beginning the track, we proceeded behind the residence of 1810 Holly Avenue. On this property there was a detached garage. Behind this

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detached garage officers located a firearm. I recovered the firearm, which was identified as a black and silver colored High Point pistol, model CF380, bearing serial number P8058101. I rendered the firearm safe and secured it. I continued assisting with the track, and recovered no further evidence.


A check through Joint Communications revealed the firearm I had recovered had been reported stolen out of Chillicothe Police Department (NCIC #G063582944). Confirmation was sent via Joint Communications, and the firearm's stolen status was confirmed. When the firearm was recovered, it had been loaded with three cartridges in the magazine, and one cartridge in the chamber. These cartridges were yellow colored, .380 caliber, and bore a "GFL" stamp.


I later submitted the firearm into Evidence at the Columbia Police Department. I have requested the firearm to be sent to the Missouri State Highway Patrol Lab for DNA and print analysis due to its connection with the robbery and gunshot victim. My Axon body camera was active during my assistance with this incident and the footage was later tagged as evidence.
