On 02-16-2017 beginning at approximately 1603 hours Detective Randy Nichols and I interviewed suspect Kaulic Williams regarding this case. The interview was recorded, and a CD copy was entered into Evidence. The video also contains a

conversation between Williams and Detective Chad Reynolds about a separate case. What follows is a summary of the interview about this case, for complete details see the recording.

I told Williams we wanted to talk to him about James Webb. I read Williams the Miranda Rights. Williams said he understood his rights, and agreed to talk to us.

I asked Williams why he thought we would want to talk to him about Webb, Williams said he had no idea. I asked when he last saw Webb. Williams said it was about two weeks ago, when he (Williams) took a television to Webb's apartment. Williams said this was after Webb was released from jail for the forgery case, and before his most recent arrest.

I asked Williams what he knew about Webb being in jail again. Williams said he knew nothing about it, and that he was not even curious about it. I informed Williams we had information that he (Williams) was involved in the offense for which Webb was in jail. Williams' response was "What day was this?".

I asked Williams to supply a DNA sample to compare to evidence collected in the case. Williams said he would not provide a sample. Williams proceeded to tell us what his daily routine was, and said his roommate, Jessica Conner, could "vouch" for him. Detective Nichols later tried to contact Conner by phone, but got no answer.

I told Williams the date we were interested in was 01-27-2017. Williams said he he did not know what he did on that day, but checked his phone to find out. Williams located a photo of a new tattoo he said he got in Columbia that day. Williams said he was at home at 10:16 AM (the time of the photo of his tattoo). I informed Williams the incident happened at night.

Williams said his regular day consists of working from 8-6, then going home - both Williams' home and job are in Jefferson City. Williams said he was not in Columbia on that Friday night. Williams said he did not remember if he was with anyone that night.

I asked Williams why people would be telling us he was with Webb that night. Williams said he had no idea. I then asked Williams if Webb had any friends that someone might think was Williams. Williams said were not, and I then asked about accomplices. Williams then began to talk about "Jada" (known to be Lynda Young, a prostitute who worked out of 1125 Vandiver Drive). Williams said Jada has been "against us for the longest" and explained that Webb kicked her out of his (Webb's) house. Williams added that Jada has been "trying to attack us" and trying to get him and Webb put in jail.

I asked Williams why Jada had something against him. Williams said that Jada was like a sister to him, and she got "pissed" that Williams wanted to help her when Webb kicked her out. Williams said he broke ties with Jada as well when Webb kicked her out, which upset Jada. Williams said Webb kicked Jada out because the two had an "attachment to each other" and Webb felt like it was time to cut her off.

I asked Williams where Jada worked. Williams explained that Jada "sells herself" and lives near Columbia Honda and a Waffle House (known to be 1125 Vandiver). Williams said he had picked Jada up at the Vandiver Drive house to give her a ride, but he said he never went inside.

I told Williams we knew he was involved with Webb in the check forgery operation, and Williams nodded his head in the affirmative. I also told Williams we knew Jada was involved in the forgeries, but that we were not investigating that (the forgeries). I then pressed Williams about the reason Jada had a falling out. I asked Williams if there was a money issue between Webb and Jada. Williams said there was, and explained that Jada was "bringing in money...she didn't want to anymore". when I asked how Jada was bringing in money, Williams said she was "selling herself". Williams said this money was used for "providing for the house", and that Jada was "basically paying rent".

Detective Nichols asked Williams what Jada called him. Williams said he was called "Little Legs". Williams added that he mostly uses his middle name, Michael.

I asked Williams about the photos he and Webb took where they were both holding guns (photos found on Webb's phone during the forgery investigation). Williams said he was excited because he had just bought his first gun. Williams said he knew nothing about the pistol Webb has in the pictures, although Williams said he did see the pistol. Williams told us it was Jada who took the pictures. I told Williams the pictures looked like they were getting ready to go rob someone. Williams said he has never robbed anyone, and to his knowledge, neither has Webb.

I again told Williams we had information that he was with Webb on the night in question, and that they were involved in "pretty bad stuff". Williams said he was not there, and then agreed to provide a DNA sample. I then used a buccal swab to collect a sample. I entered the swab into Evidence, and requested it be sent to the crime lab for comparison to case evidence.

I asked Williams if he knew any other girls who work at the Vandiver Drive house. Williams said he did not.

I asked Williams if he would allow us to make a copy of his cell phone data.


