On 02-21-2017 beginning at approximately 0938 hours Detective Randy Nichols and I interviewed Sydney Akers at the Boone County Sheriff's Department. Suspect James Webb had named Akers as an alibi witness for himself. Akers was being held at the Boone County Jail on charges not related to this case. Our interview was recorded, and a DVD copy was entered into Evidence. What follows is a summary, for complete details see the recording.

I read Akers the Miranda Rights. Akers said she understood her rights, and agreed to speak to us. I asked Akers how she knew James Webb. Akers said she met Webb through some friends when Webb came over to Akers' friend's apartment. Akers estimated she met Webb about a week before Webb's recent arrest (02-03-2017). Akers said she did not know what day of the week she met Webb.

Akers explained she was at the apartment of Rodney Reaws when she met Webb. Akers listed Reaws' girlfriend Tiaira (West) and Jacob Wilson as also being present. Akers said she believed Reaws went to pick Webb up, and brought Webb to the apartment. Akers said Webb was by himself when Reaws brought him over.

Akers said she dropped Jacob Wilson off, and she and Webb were together the whole night talking in her car "until the sun came up". Akers confirmed that this was the first night she met Webb. I asked Akers what time Webb came over that night. Akers said it was "maybe after midnight". Akers said she was with Webb "like everyday after that" with the exception of "one day, one night". Akers then said the incident for which Webb was arrested "supposedly happened that night...that I met him". I asked Akers how she knew that, and she answered "Because I talked to him" after his arrest (a phone call from jail).

I asked Akers where Rodney Reaws went to pick up Webb the night she first met him (Webb). Akers said she thought it was from Webb's house, because "they were gone and back" in a short amount of time the trip took - Akers explained that Webb lived across the street. I questioned Akers about who went with Reaws, since she used the term "they". Akers said she did not know, and added that Reaws did not even have a car. Akers then said she was "under the influence" that night, and it could even have been her who picked Webb up.

I asked Akers what Webb was wearing when she met him. Akers said Webb was wearing a black hat "like a beanie", maybe jeans, and a black shirt. I then asked what Webb was talking about that night. Akers said Webb did not seem as if anything was wrong, and was talking about how he just got out of jail "like six days ago".

I discussed with Akers the dangers of providing a false alibi for someone. I told Akers Webb told us he was with her on the night of the crime. Akers responded that she did not know what night "he supposedly did this shit", and that Webb told her in a jail call that he could not remember anything in the interrogation room but "it all came back to him" on the phone with her.

I asked Akers if she knew Kaulic Williams. Akers said she did not, and she had only met one of Webb's friends named Tyler.


I asked Akers if she ever saw Webb with a gun, and she said she did not. When I asked if Webb ever talked about having guns, Akers said he talked about not having one. Akers explained that she had asked Webb who he was "beefing" with, and Webb said he was not beefing with anyone. Akers said Webb commented that he felt "bare" not having a gun. Akers said Webb did tell her about a girl who "snitched on him" and caused him to get arrested. Akers said Webb did not tell her why this girl snitched on him, and it did not seem like Webb was worried about it.

I have reviewed the phone records for James Webb, and the first contact between Webb and Akers I could locate was on 01-27-2017 at 0138 (local time). This is prior to the robbery, suggesting that Webb and Akers first met at least the night before the robbery.
