1125 Vandiver Drive, where a burglary with a gun just occurred. Upon responding emergency a Boone County Deputy stated he was in a vehicle pursuit and the a foot pursuit on Parker Street traveling East Bond on Holly Avenue.

I believed I was the closest on scene so I responded towards his location to assist him. I began traveling East bound on Holly Avenue and was flagged down by the deputy near a wooded area on the south side of the road. I parked my patrol vehicle in front of 1810 Holly Avenue and went to assist the deputy search for the subjects in the woods.

I then went back to my patrol vehicle and was flagged down by the resident at 1810 Holly who advised he heard some noise by the south west end of his house, near a detached two car garage. The resident stated the garage is not secured in anyway and it was possible people were hiding in there. I altered Officer Parsons.

There was approximately 3 deputies, Officer Schuster, Officer Parsons and his canine Raf that came to the residence. We then approached the garage to look for suspects. Officer Schuster and I went to the west side of the garage and then approached the rear, south side. Upon getting to the south side of the garage Officer Schuster located a handgun on the ground. We then cleared the garage.

A black coat was then found in the backyard of 1810 Holly. After Canine Raf was able to pick up a scent, the track began traveling east bound. I stayed with the coat and searched it to look for any identification. I did locate \$45.00 dollars in cash in one of the pockets in the coat.

I stayed with the coat and then when the perimeter collapsed I collected it. I also took photographs of where the coat was located as well as the location of where the firearm was recovered by Officer Schuster.

After taking photographs, I then followed the tow truck with the suspect vehicle to the Columbia Police Department Training Center. Upon arrival at the training center I sealed the vehicle off with evidence tape, intialing on the tape on every door. I also placed crime scene tape around the vehicle.

I placed the coat, currency, and a CD containg photographs of the scene in evidence locker 11 at the Columbia Police Department. I also tagged my Axon body camera footage under this case number.


