INCIDENT NARRATIVE

ON 01/29/2017 AT APPROXIMATELY 2312 HOURS I RESPONDED TO THE 1100 BLK OF VANDIVER FOR REPORT OF A BURGLARY WITH POSSIBLE SHOTS FIRED.

NARRATIVE

On 1/27/2017 at approximately 2312 hours, I was on a traffic stop in the area of Whitegate and Paris Road when I heard alert tones for a robbery in progress at. I broke from my traffic stop and activated my lights and sirens then proceeded northbound on Paris Road and eventually turned westbound onto Vandiver. I arrived in the area of 1125 Vandiver, the target location at approximately 2315 hours and information was given that the suspects were no longer at the residence. I drove to the scene continuing westbound and I parked just east of the driveway.

I made my way inside being the first officer on scene, I made a loud announcement that I was with the, "Columbia Police Department" and I was coming inside. I entered the residence and observed several people, one of which was later identified as Tana Martay Roland. Roland stated something to the effect of "I've been shot in the stomach." I directed Roland to the porch area and had her lie down on her back so that I could assess her wound. I observed on her abdomen two red wounds, which were covered in blood, which I believed to be gunshot wounds. I began applying pressure to the wounds to stop the bleeding and asked Roland how many times she had been shot. Roland stated she had only been shot once. It appeared to me that the gunshot wound appeared to enter one side and exit the other side approximately six inches apart horizontally across her abdomen.

Emergency medical personnel arrived and began giving Roland primary medical care. These two individuals were identified as Amy Palmer, a paramedic, and Thomas Yeast, an EMT. I rode with Roland and medical personnel to the University Hospital so that Roland could receive treatment.

I was able to interview Roland after she had received medical attention and she gave me the following statement. Roland stated that a person she knows as "Ron" had been inside the residence with her and other individuals and had told her that someone was knocking at the door asking for her. Roland stated that her working name is "Little Bit." Roland went on to state that she answered the door, first looking and seeing that it was a black male. Roland stated that she does not typically "mess with black dudes, because they don't like to pay." Roland went on to state that she thought it may be her cousin coming to see her, so she opened the door.

Roland stated that the first black male, who was described as between 25 and 35 years of age, dark skinned, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, pulled out a gun and began yelling at her to get inside the residence. Roland described the second male as a light skinned black male in his 20's, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt.

Roland went on to state that she was directed to lie down on the ground and she heard the suspects giving loud commands for individuals to come out of their rooms and lie down on the ground. Roland stated that she initially believed that it was her cousin bringing someone over for her to conduct business with.


Roland continued stating that the first black male who had pulled out the gun went on to state something to the effect of, "We came from chi-town to rob this place." She continued by stating that they were, "Asking for the fat dude." Roland believed that they were referring to Berry Manthe. After several minutes Roland stated that they could hear sirens, presumably from our emergency equipment, and the dark skinned black male who had the gun yelled out something to the effect of, "Which one of y'all called 911?"

At this point, Roland stated she had been in what she described as a fetal position covering her face and she began to pull her knees towards her chest when the dark skinned black male began shooting. Roland stated she felt the gunshot, then the black males ran out of the residence.


Roland later explained that she believed these individuals to be associated to a girl who had been staying at Berry's house who she knew by the working name of "Monica." Roland stated that Monica had black male clients from Chicago who frequently visited her at the aforementioned address. Roland went on to state that Monica had not been at the residence for a number of days. Monica is described as an approximately 30 year old black female, small in size, from the Columbia or St. Louis area.

My Axon body camera was activated and recording during this interview and incident and has been tagged on evidence.com. My in car camera was recording and has also been tagged for purposes of this report. Any further information will be added via supplemental narrative.
