On 01-27-2017 I was contacted by Sgt. Mike Maynard and asked to assist with an investigation into a robbery at 1125 Vandiver Drive in which a person had been shot. I responded to the police station where patrol officers had brought a witness/victim, Rebecca Buschman. Beginning at approximately 0039 hours Detective Randy Nichols and I interviewed Buschman. The interview was recorded, and a CD copy was put into Evidence. What follows is a summary, for complete details see the recording.

Buschman said she was in the back room of 1125 Vandiver drive when the robbery happened. Buschmann said this was the residence of Barry (Manthe) and Ron (Clark). At the time of the robbery, Buschman said she was with a friend of her's named James (Jones) in the back room. Buschman said she heard some banging, so she went to the door leading to Barry's room (which adjoins the room she was in) and asked what was going on. Buschman said she heard Ron Clark reply "We're being robbed".

Buschman said she tried to secure the doors leading into the room she was in by propping a glass table top up against one door. Continuing, Buschman said one male broke through both doors and came into her room pointing a gun at James. Buschman described the gun as an all-black semi auto, that was "more than a nine mil". Buschman said the suspect asked James "Where's the dough", and James gave the suspect all his money. The suspect also asked, Buschman said, "Where's the fat guy at?" and "Where's the bitch at?". Buschman said she was hiding under a desk at the time the suspect inquired as to the whereabouts of "the bitch", and James looked over at her after the suspect asked his question. Buschman said she was on the phone with 911 at that time. Later in the interview, Buschman said she believed the suspect was referring to Barry Manthe as the "fat guy".

Buschman went on to say that she tried to hide the phone from the suspect's view, and he asked her if she had called 911. Buschman said the suspect told her to give him her phone, and she did. Buschman said once the suspect saw that her phone was making an emergency call, he threw it down and ran out.

Buschman said she later learned from one for the other victims (Justin Duebner) that the suspect made yet another one of the victims (Alan King) break through the door to the room she was in.

Buschman said she only saw one suspect come into her room. She described him as a black male, darker-medium skin tone, late teens to mid twenties, scraggly goatee, close cut hair on the sides, and brown eyes. Buschman said the suspect was wearing a navy blue hoodie, black pants, and possibly black tennis shoes with white on them. Buschman described the suspect's face as "wider". Buschman said she did not recognize the suspect.

Buschman named the following people as being present at the house at the time of the robbery:

Buschmann said she was told in conversation with the other occupants of the house that there were two suspects in the robbery. Buschman said she only saw one of the suspects, and that she would recognize him if she saw him again.

When I asked Buschman why someone would want to break into Barry's house, Buschman said "Money". I asked her why Barry would have a lot of money in the house, and she answered that he does not have a lot of money and that was what was "funny" about it. Detective Nichols asked Buschman about drugs in the house. Buschman denied that she had any drugs in the house, and said she did not know about anyone else. Buschman said she is at Barry's house only to "hang out", and that she has fixed up a room in Barry's house just to "hang out" in and for others to "hang out" in as well. Barry Manthe's house is known by police to be a house of prostitution, and in their interviews Manthe and Tana Roland spoke openly about this fact.

Buschman said she got to Barry's house on Thursday (01-26-2017) "early, early morning" but had come and gone since arriving. Buschman said she had been at Barry's since 10:00-11:00 AM on Friday (01-27-2017) without leaving. Buschman said she did not know when the others got to Barry's, but she thought they were all there by 10:00-11:00 Friday when she got there - except for Alan King, whom she said she thought got there around noon on Friday.

Buschman said all of the persons were regulars at Barry's house, except for James Jones. Buschman then said James got to Barry's about 20 minutes before the robbery. When asked how James knew she was there, Buschman said he had called her.


I asked Buschman when during the robbery Tana Roland was shot. Buschman said she heard a gunshot and screaming after the suspect left her room. Buschman explained that she was told later by Dueber and King that the suspect who went into her room fired the shot as he (the suspect) was leaving.

I asked Buschman if any of the others said anything about knowing the suspects. Buschman said they did not, and added again that she had never seen the suspect who came into her room before.
