PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I, NICHOLS, RANDELL ODON
UPON MY OATH, AND UNDER PENALTIES OF PERJURY, state as follows:

- 1. I have probable cause to believe that WEBB, JAMES FERNANDO committed the offense(s) of:
 - 565.050 FIRST DEGREE ASSAULT
 - 565.110 KIDNAPPING
 - 570.023 ROBBERY IN THE FIRST DEGREE
 - 571.015 ARMED CRIMINAL ACTION

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:
On 1/27/17 at approximately 23:00hrs officers of the Columbia Police Department were dispatched to a robbery with a gun located at 1125 Vandiver Drive located in Columbia Missouri. 1125 Vandiver Drive is a residential dwelling. Officers were also notified that one subject had been shot. The description given of the robbers was two black males with guns. Both subjects had left the scene prior to officers arrival.

Officers interviewed victim JJ. JJ stated that he was in a rear bedroom of the residence with a friend and witness, RB. JJ stated that a black male subject had forced entry into the bedroom he was located yelling "where's the bread at, where's the fat man at?". Jones advised that he handed over cash to the male. Jones also advised that the suspect had a hand gun. JJ advised that the suspect took a cellular phone from RB and threw it on the ground.

I talked to victim, RB. RB stated that she was in a bedroom located at 1125 Vandiver Drive. RB said she was in the room with her friend JJ. RB said that she heard a commotion and loud banging and a male yelling. RB said that she heard someone banging on her doors and eventually force their way in to her room. RB said the person who broke into her room was a black male with a hand gun. RB said she had been hiding behind her bed and was on the phone with the 911 operator. RB said that the black male took her cellular phone from her and threw it on the floor then left her bedroom.

Officers interviewed victim JD. JD told officers that he and his friend EH, were in the bedroom of the dwelling and when they heard the males yelling and demanding property they then ran to a bathroom. JD advised he and EH were leaving the bathroom when they were approached by a suspect who stated "where's the bread?". JD stated that he gave the suspect cash. JD stated that he later heard at least two gun shots in the residence prior to the suspects leaving.

Officer's interviewed victim EH. EH stated that she was entering the living room when she witnessed a black male with a "hoodie" holding a gun enter the room. EH stated that the black male demanded money from her. EH said that she gave him her money.



I interviewed victim AK. AK stated that he was in the bathroom of 1125 Vandiver Drive when he heard a loud commotion outside. AK stated that one of the black males confronted him and made him lie down on the floor. AK stated the male was yelling wanting to know where the "fat man was?". AK said that he heard a shot and he believed the black male doing all of the yelling had shot a gun while he was trying to force entry into a rear door. AK said the black male then yelled at him to force the door open to the back bedroom or he would start shooting. AK said he got up and broke the glass out of the door.

I interviewed victim TR. TR said that she was in a bedroom by herself when she was told someone was knocking at the front door. TR said that when she went to the door she did recognize by moniker the second suspect. TR said when she opened the door suspect one then showed a hand gun and started yelling at her that this was a robbery and to get on the floor. TR stated that the suspect said "i'm from Chicago, I heard about ya'll", TR stated he then asked "where's the fat man?" and "where's the bitch at?". TR said at that point she recognized the individual from recent contact with a friend named LY. TR said that suspect one was a boyfriend of LY, known to her as "Jamo" or his real name of James Webb. A photo array with James Webb in the array was shown to TR. TR picked James Webb out of the array and said he was the one that shot her and forced her on the floor. TR also said that Webb forced her friend, AK, to help him(Webb) break into RB's room.

On 01/27/2017, at approximately 2314 hours, I was dispatched to 1125 Vandiver Drive in Columbia, Missouri for a report of a robbery with a gun in progress.

I arrived on scene at approximately 2318 hours. Sgt. Andy Meyer instructed me to continue towards Parker Street where a Deputy had gotten into a foot pursuit with possible suspects. I arrived at the intersection of Holly and Parker Street and assisted with a felony traffic stop on the suspect vehicle.

I was then instructed by Sgt. Jeff Forck to respond to the area of Oakland Gravel and Holly Avenue to work perimeter for the track. I arrived at approximately 2327 hours.

At approximately 2333 hours, I was instructed by Sgt. Andy Meyer to respond to the 1125 Vandiver to assist with the investigation.

I arrived at 1125 Vandiver at approximately 2335 hours. Sgt. Meyer instructed me to start interviewing witnesses and figure out which ones observed anything so they could be transported to the Columbia Police Department for further interview by Detectives.

The first person I interviewed identified herself as Rebecca E. Buschman. Buschman stated she had been in her back bedroom with a friend when she heard several loud bangs on her door. Buschman stated she observed a black male wearing a navy blue hoodie and dark jeans or sweat pants enter her room. Buschman futher described the suspect has wearing shoes with white print on them, as a younger medium to dark skinned black male with a thin goatee, a wider face, medium sized nose, and thin eyebrows. Buschman stated the male kept saying something similar to, "where's the money" "where's the bitch" and "where's the fat man". Buschman stated the suspect pointed the gun at her and

at her "friend" several times. Buschman stated her "friend" gave the man money as she hid hers under her bed. Buschman stated the suspect then left out of the room and she heard one loud pop, and her roommates saying something similar to, "they shot her, they shot her".

As I was interviewing Buschman, I observed a white male arrive on scene, who was later identified as the property owner, Christopher Felten. Sgt. Meyer asked me to interview Felten. Felten stated earlier in the day, at approximately 1500 hours, he had observed what he believed to be a light tan Chevy Trailblazer pull up to the fence behind the residence. Felten stated he heard a black male yelling at a female (unknown race) as she walked down the street to the east of the residence. Felten stated he had gone back to make contact with the subject and ask him not to park there, but the male had gone. Felten stated he later observed the same light tan Chevy Trailblazer at the apartments on Northland Avenue just past the trailer park on the north side. Felten was not present during the Robbery and could not confirm or deny the vehicles involvement in the crime.

I next interviewed Barry Manthe who stated he was in his bedroom in the back of the house when the crime took place. Manthe stated he did not see anything and only heard arguing and loud bangs. Manthe stated his roommate, Ronny (Ronald Clark) entered his room and told him a male was there with a gun and to call 911. Manthe stated he called 911 and talked to Boone County Joint Communications.

I next interviewed Ronald Clark. Clark stated he had been in the living room kitchen area when he heard the doorbell ring. Clark stated he observed his roommate (the victim, please refer to supplemental report for name), go and open the door. Clark stated he observed a black male with a cap on push the victim inside the residence while holding a gun. Clark stated at this point he ran back to Manthe's room and called told Manthe to call 911. Clark stated he got on the phone with 911 operators after Manthe called them.

I next interviewed Elizabeth Hendricks. Hendricks stated she had been in the living room area when she observed a black male with a hoodie on holding a gun enter the room. Hendricks stated the black male said something similar to, "get the fuck down", "where's the money", and "where's the fat man". Hendricks stated the suspects stole \$110 US from her.

After interviewing the above subjects I worked as scene security while waiting for Detectives to arrive with a Search Warrant.




