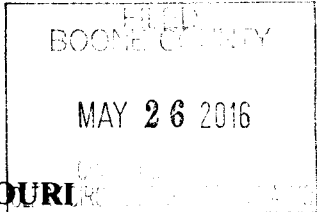

**COMPLAINT**

The Prosecuting Attorney of the County of Boone, State of Missouri, upon information and belief, charges that the defendant:

**COUNT I:** In violation of Section 195.202, RSMo, committed the class C felony of possession of a controlled substance, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about May 26, 2016, in the County of Boone, State of Missouri, the defendant possessed heroin, a controlled substance, knowing of its presence and nature.

**COUNT II:** In violation of Section 571.030.1(11), RSMo, committed the class D felony of unlawful use of a weapon, punishable upon conviction under Sections 558.011 and 560.011, RSMo, in that on or about May 26, 2016, on Providence Road at or near Business Loop 70, in the County of Boone, State of Missouri, defendant knowingly possessed a firearm, a Witness PS handgun, while knowingly possessing a controlled substance, heroin, that is sufficient for a felony violation of section 195.202.

The facts that form the basis for this information and belief are contained in the attached statement(s) to facts concerning this matter, which statements are made a part hereof and are submitted herewith as a basis upon which this court may find the existence of probable cause for the issuance of the warrant.

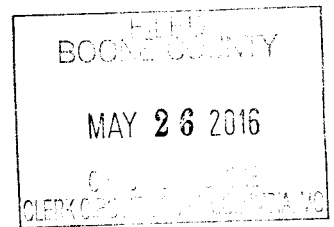
Wherefore, the Prosecuting Attorney prays that a warrant be issued as provided by law.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I, MCIFF, RANDOLPH B
knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law,
state that the facts contained herein are true.

- 1. I have probable cause to believe that on 05/26/2016, at
900 I70 DR SOUTHWEST-CO
JONES, KENNETH RON JR B/M 12/15/1991
committed one or more criminal offense(s):
195.202F POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE - FELONY
571.030F UNLAWFUL USE OF WEAPONS - FELONY
302.020M OPERATED VEHICLE ON HIGHWAY W/O VALID LICENSE

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:
On May 26, 2016 at approximately 0248 hours, Kenneth R. Jones committed the
following crimes Possession of a Controlled Substance Felony and Unlawful use
of a Weapon by doing the following:

On May 26, 2016 at approximately 0248 hours. I was on patrol traveling south on
Providence Road near Business Loop 70. While traveling on Providence Road, I
observed a 2001 BMW bearing Missouri Registration WK0A7M not use its turn
signal while turning west onto Business Loop 70 East from Providence Road.

I conducted a traffic stop with the above vehicle for the Fail to Signal AT 900
I70 Drive Southwest. I made contact with the driver identified as Kenneth R.
Jones and passenger D.T. A check with communications advised Kenneth R. Jones
to not have a Drivers License.

I asked Kenneth R. Jones to exit the vehicle and placed him under arrest for
operating a motor vehicle without a drivers license. While conducting an
inventory search of Kenneth R. Jones I located in his right front jean pocket a
clear plastic baggie, which contained approximately 2.5 grams of a white and
brown crystal substance. Upon conducting a field drug test, the substance
tested positive for heroin and amphetamines.


Due to locating the controlled substance on Kenneth R. Jones person, I
conducted a further search of the vehicle. Upon searching the vehicle I located
under the drivers seat a loaded Witness PS firearm which had one round in the
chamber and eight rounds in the magazine. I was unable to obtain the serial
number for the firearm due to the last three numbers being un readable.

- 3. For the issuance of a warrant in a misdemeanor case, complete the following
(a) I believe that the defendant will not appear in court in response to
a criminal summons because:
Kenneth R. Jones was in possession of a controlled substance which tested
positive for heroin and amphetamine and a loaded firearm.

(b) I believe that defendant poses  
(1) a danger to a crime victim because  
No victim involved

(2) a danger to the community or to any other person because  
Kenneth R. Jones is a danger to others due to being in possession of a  
loaded firearm and a controlled substance.
